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Introduction

Jesus' 1st Coming

We find it difficult today to understand why the people of Jesus' day rejected him. The problem originated from the misconceptions that were in the minds of the people, taught to them by the religious leaders of their day. These misconceptions or **errors** held by the people **prevented them** from accepting truth and even Jesus Himself! They believed the Messiah would set up a **visible** kingdom.

Jesus' 2nd Coming

You'd think we would be wiser today, with their experience behind us, but Jesus warned that the same problem would exist again just before His second coming.

Once again the Religious Leaders will have misled the people and there will be false christs, and false teachings. This time the people will have been led to believe that Jesus will be **invisible** when He comes.

Therefore hath the curse devoured the earth...Therefore <u>the inhabitants of the earth are burned</u>, and <u>few men left</u>."</p>	<p><i>The <u>condition of the earth and the condition of its inhabitants after Jesus has come!</u></i></p>

<p>I Thessalonians 4:16,17 "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are <u>alive and remain</u> shall be <u>caught up together</u> with them in the clouds, <u>to meet the Lord in the air</u>: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."</p>	<p><i>The <u>righteous</u> will "<u>remain</u>" or be left alive when Jesus comes while the wicked will be slain.</i></p>

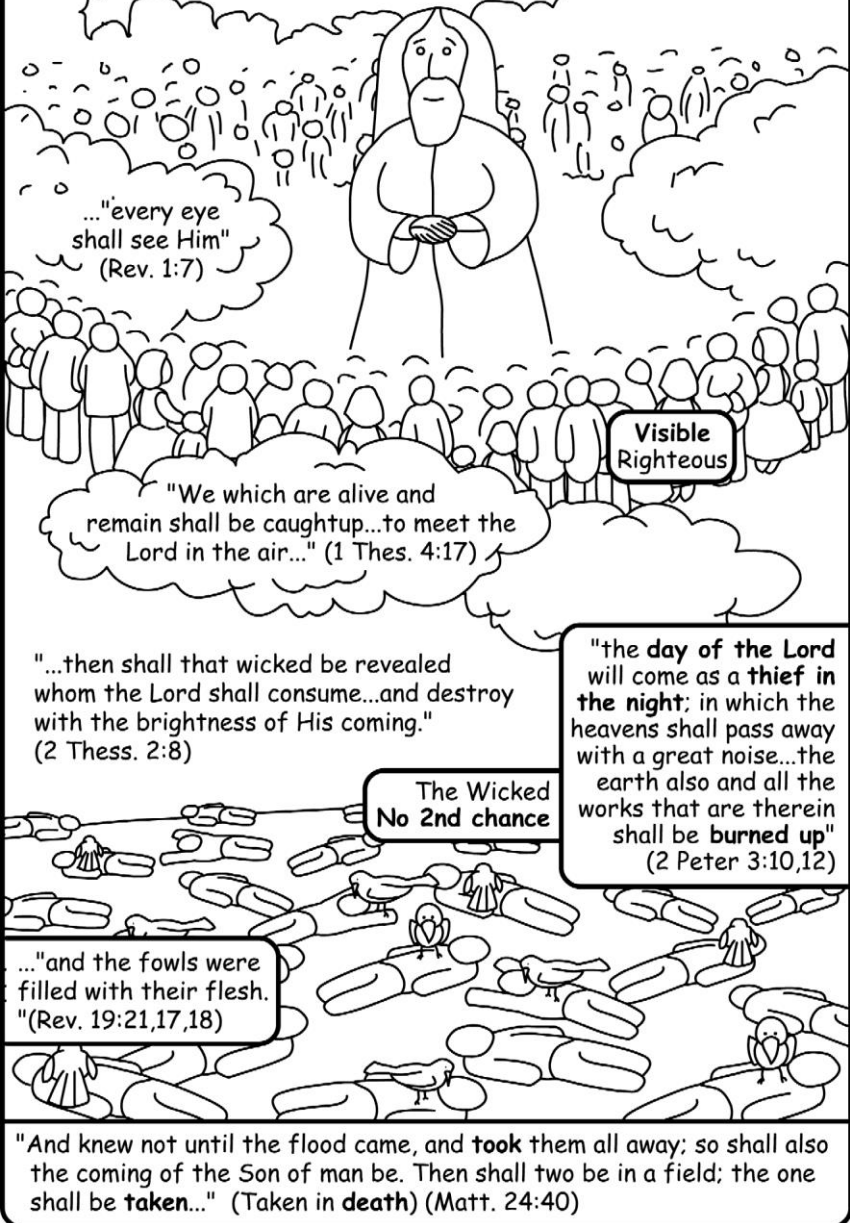

And he <u>laid hold on the dragon</u>, that old serpent, which is the <u>Devil and Satan</u>, and <u>bound him a thousand years</u>, and <u>cast him into the bottomless pit</u> and <u>shut him up</u>, and set a seal upon him, that he should <u>deceive the nations no more</u>, <u>till the thousand years should be fulfilled</u>: and after that he must be loosed a little season."</p>	<p><i><u>The Devil will not be able to deceive anyone for a long time (1,000 years)</u></i></p>
<p>Revelation 20: 4,6,5</p> <p>"And I saw thrones, and they that sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: And I saw the souls of them that were <u>beheaded for the witness of Jesus and for the word of God</u>, and which <u>had not worshipped the Beast</u>, neither his image, <u>neither had received his mark</u> upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they <u>lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years</u>. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the <u>first resurrection</u>: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years. And He carried me away in the spirit to a <u>great and high mountain</u>, and showed me that great city, the <u>new Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God.</u>"</p>	<p><i>The <u>holy city, new Jerusalem</u> comes down <u>out of heaven</u> and comes <u>to rest on earth where the mount of Olives was</u> before the feet of Jesus split it.</i></p>
<p>Revelation 20:7-9 "And <u>when the thousand years are expired</u>, <u>Satan</u> ... shall go out to deceive the nations...<u>to gather them together to battle</u>: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. 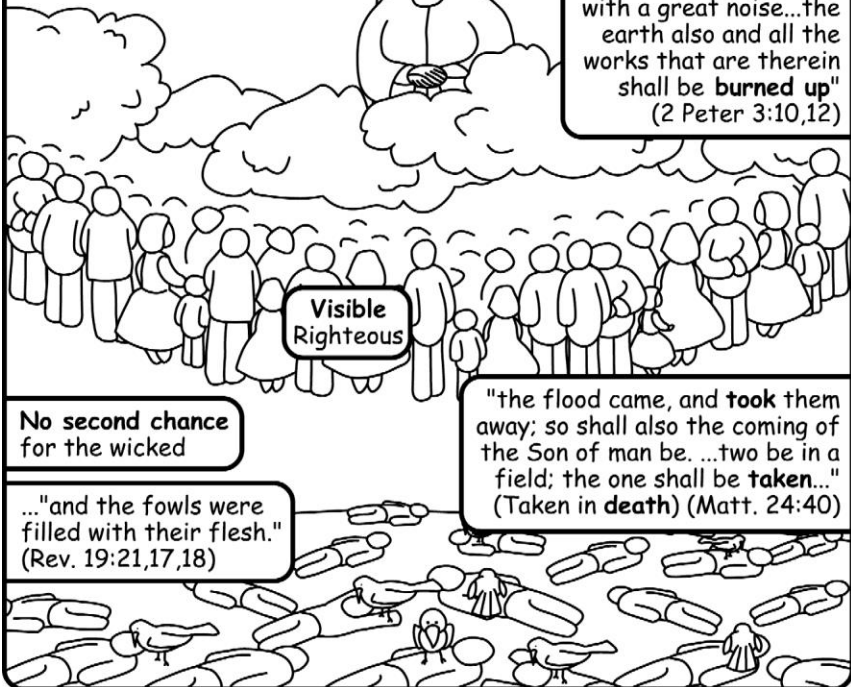

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Introduction

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LESSON THIRTY-SEVENTH.

ON THE LAST JUDGMENT AND RESURRECTION,
HELL, PURGATORY AND HEAVEN.

Q. 1371. When will Christ judge us?

A. Christ will judge us immediately after our death, and on the last day.

Q. 1372. What is the judgment called which we have to undergo immediately after death?

A. The judgment we have to undergo immediately after death is called the Particular Judgment.

Q. 1373. Where will the particular judgment be held?

A. The particular judgment will be held in the place where each person dies, and the soul will go immediately to its reward or punishment.

Popular Teaching (continued)

Catholic Catechism

Q. 1378. What are the rewards or punishments appointed for men's souls after the Particular Judgment?

A. The rewards or punishments appointed for men's souls after the Particular Judgment are Heaven, Purgatory, and Hell.

Q. 1379. What is Hell?

A. Hell is a state to which the wicked are condemned, and in which they are deprived of the sight of God for all eternity, and are in dreadful torments.

Q. 1380. Will the damned suffer in both mind and body?

A. The damned will suffer in both mind and body, because both mind and body had a share in their sins. The mind suffers the "pain of loss" in which it is tortured by the thought of having lost God forever, and the body suffers the "pain of sense" by which it is tortured in all its members and senses.

Q. 1398. Are the rewards in heaven and the punishments in hell the same for all who enter into either of these states?

A. The rewards of heaven and the punishments in hell are not the same for all who enter into either of these states, because each one's reward or punishment is in proportion to the amount of good or evil he has done in this world. But as heaven and hell are everlasting, each one will enjoy his reward or suffer his punishment forever.

Q. 1400. Name some of the more essential religious truths we must know and believe.

A. Some of the more essential religious truths we must know and believe are:

(1) That there is but one God, and He will reward the good and punish the wicked.

(2) That in God there are three Divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, and these Divine Persons are called the Blessed Trinity.

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Introduction

The subject of Death or What happens when a person dies is **very important** to understand. The majority of people do not have a **Biblical** understanding of death. Their understanding is based on "hearsay" or TV or what they have been told by their pastor, priest, or friend! What is meant by the term "immortal soul" and where did this concept come from?

Edward White, in his book "Life in Christ" states that "the doctrine of the immortal soul is never once explicitly given in the Scriptures." He states that including Jewish writings, over 100 writers have all failed to give any reference to an immortal soul.

"We might naturally expect that a principle so essential to religion would have been revealed in the clearest terms to the chosen people of Palestine, and that it might safely have been intrusted to the hereditary priesthood of Aaron. It is incumbent on us to adore the mysterious dispensations of Providence, when we discover that the doctrine of the immortality of the soul is omitted in the law of Moses;....

After Cyrus had permitted the exiled nation to return into the promised land, and after Ezra had restored the ancient records of their religion, two celebrated sects, the Sadducees, and the Pharisees, insensibly arose at Jerusalem. The former selected from the more opulent and distinguished ranks of society, were strictly attached to the literal sense of the Mosaic law, and they piously rejected the immortality of the soul, as an opinion that received no countenance from the divine book, which they revered as the only rule of their faith. To the authority of scripture the Pharisees added that of tradition, and they accepted, under the name of traditions,

several speculative tenets from the philosophy or religion of the eastern nations.

The doctrines of fate or predestination, of angels and spirits, and of a future state of rewards and punishments, were in the number of these new articles of belief; and as the Pharisees, by the austerity of their manners, had drawn into their party the body of the Jewish people, the immortality of the soul became the prevailing sentiment of the synagogue under the reign of the Asmonaeen princes and pontiffs. The temper of the Jews was incapable of contenting itself with such a cold and languid assent as might satisfy the mind of a Polytheist; and as soon as they admitted the idea of a future state, they embraced it with the zeal which has always formed the characteristic of the nation. Their zeal, however, added nothing to its evidence, or even probability;...”

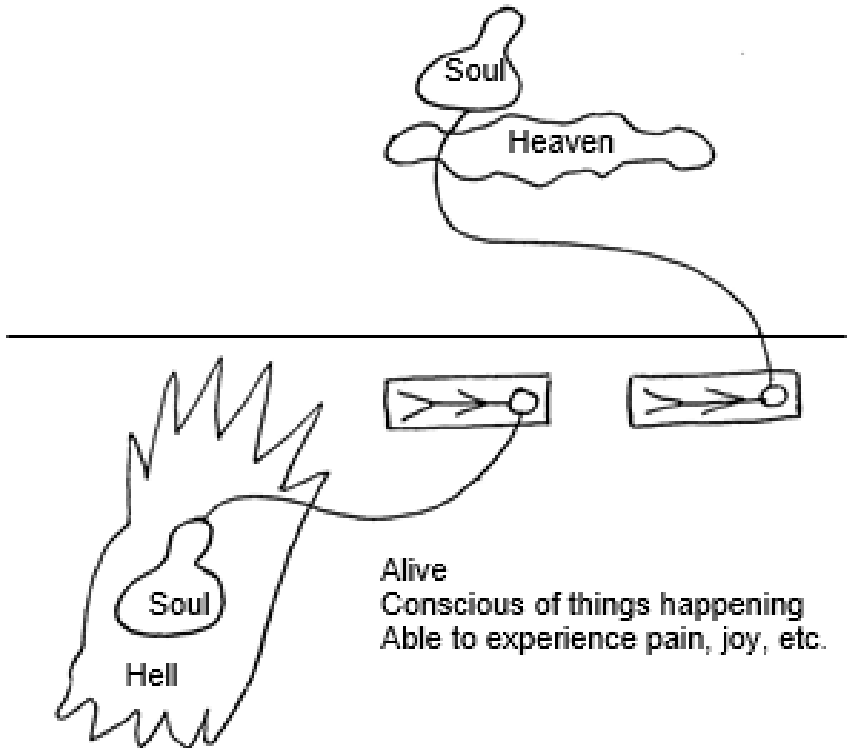
IMPORTANT POINTS ABOUT DEATH

1. The concept of "Life after Death" or an "Immortal Soul" came from Greek Pagan philosophers.
2. The Pharisees added tradition to their teachings and taught the people the Pagan Greek belief of the immortal soul.
3. **Jesus condemned** the doctrine of the Pharisees, who taught "immortality of the soul."
4. Jesus said that the traditions or "commandments of men" was vain (useless) worship.
5. The people that trusted their religious leaders instead of trusting the scriptures were "in darkness" or deceived!
6. The Bible or Scriptures call death a sleep.
7. The Bible says a person who is dead has no knowledge, no love, no hatred, no envy, no reward, no memory, and that they praise not the Lord.
8. The Bible says that "none can keep alive his own soul," and that the soul that sinneth it shall die."
9. The Hebrew word "Ruwach," translated as "spirit", simply means "breath" or "wind."
10. Those that are "in the graves" or dead are awaiting the resurrection day.
11. On the **resurrection day** (1st resurrection), the righteous dead will be given the **gift of immortality**.
12. At the 2nd resurrection of the wicked dead, they (the wicked) will be given life temporarily and then be destroyed by fire coming down from God out of Heaven. They will become ashes under foot and cease to exist.
13. Thus, the Bible says that when a person is dead they **cease from living**. They **do not** go on living in just another form. **Death** is the opposite of **Life**. Eternal Life is a gift from God which is **not given** to the wicked.

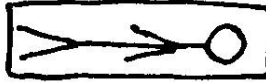

Popular Teaching (About Death and immortal soul) (Lutheran)

In *Luther's Small Catechism* under the "Apostle's Creed" page 143, article 197, the catechism teaches that when a believing person dies, their soul immediately goes to be with Christ. The reference cited is Luke 23:43,

"Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise."

Note 1: The reason that the above reference is not quoted directly is that the material is protected by copyright laws.

Note 2: Review pages 58 and 59 of the "Bible Concept of Death compared to Popular Belief" for comments concerning the Bible reference cited (Luke 23:43).

The following text by Paul is often used to attempt to “prove” the concept of “immortality of the soul” and “separation of the soul from the body”.

2 Corinthians 5:8

“We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and present with the Lord.”

Notice how the following texts, also by Paul, explain his previous “hard to understand” text.

1 Corinthians 5:3

“For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed.”

Colossians 2:5

“For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ.”

1 Thessalonians 2:17

“But we, brethren, being taken from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavoured the more abundantly to see your face with great desire.”

Remember also that Paul (who wrote Corinthians, Colossians, and Thessalonians) said...

1 Corinthians 15:53 “this **mortal** must put on **immortality**.”

Paul did not believe in the immortality of the soul or separation of the soul from the body.

Summary:

By now, you have seen what I have seen... that Bible Concepts or Bible Teachings *greatly differ* from the teachings of the Popular churches and Popular leaders.

What will you believe, dear reader?
The **Bible** or Popular opinion?
