In order to determine the <u>Spiritual</u> meaning of this Acted Parable, we will:

- 1. Locate the Real Objects and Key words,
- 2. Determine their Spiritual and Literal meanings,
- 3. Substitute those meanings back into the Acted Parable and Paraphrase it.

1 Samuel 14

The **Bible** mentions **two rocks**:

Deuteronomy 32

31 For their **rock** is not as our **Rock**, even our enemies themselves being judges.

37 And he shall say, where are their **gods**, their **rocks** in whom they trusted.

1 Corinthians 10

4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink; for they drank of that spiritual **Rock** that followed them; and that **Rock** was **Christ**.

Thus, the two rocks represent "two gods".

One **Rock** represents the **LORD** (CHRIST).

One rock represents SATAN.

Therefore:

The "Rock" BOZEZ represents the $\underline{\text{True God}}$ (CHRIST)

(shining, white, fine linen)

The "**rock**" **SENEH** represents the <u>False God</u> (SATAN) (thorn, to prick, bramble)

② The <u>two cities</u>, as **far apart** as the compass directions of **North** and **South**, represent the "actions" of the two **persons**,

[NORTH] MICHMASH # 4363 HIDDEN

(hidden under a bushel)

[SOUTH] **GIBEAH** # 1390 **LITTLE HILL**

(city set on a hill)

GODS "ACTIONS" are always in <u>plain view</u> while Satan's "actions" are <u>secretive</u>.

The <u>two directions</u>, **NORTH** and **SOUTH** represent the "**positions**" of the <u>two **persons**</u>.

NORTH – The "**rightful**" **position** of God as our <u>ruler</u>, which has been <u>usurped</u> by **Satan** (Isaiah 14 : 13).

The <u>enemies</u> of Gods people always came from the **North**.

(Jeremiah 1:14, Jeremiah 4:6, Jeremiah 6:1)

The "Valley" (passage between two cliffs) represents a decision.

Joel 3: 14 Multitudes, multitudes in the <u>valley</u> of <u>decision</u>: for the day of the Lord is near in the <u>valley</u> of <u>decision</u>.

SUMMARY

(SPIRITUAL MEANING of the "ACTED PARABLE"

In the story or "acted parable", <u>Jonathan</u> is on a **journey** to **fight** with <u>his **enemy**</u>.

As he travels, he must pass through a **valley** where the **two rocks** are.

Jonathan represents a person on the "journey of life".

Each person must enter the "<u>valley of **decision**</u>" and they must **choose** between the "<u>two **rocks**</u>".

They will either choose: the "rock BOZEZ" which represents the pure life (shining, white, fine linen) of CHRIST, the true Rock, or they will choose the "rock SENEH" which represents the wicked life (prick, thorn, bramble) of Satan.

The Hair of Thine Head is like Purple (Song of Sol 7:5)

"Thine head upon thee is like Carmel, and the hair of thine head like purple; the King is held in the galleries".

QUESTIONS

- 1. What are the <u>real objects</u> and key words in this text?
- 2. What is the Spiritual meaning of each real object?
- 3. What is the context of this verse in the setting of Chapter 7 of Song of Solomon?
- 4. What does this verse mean <u>Spiritually</u>, since it can't be understood <u>Physically</u> or <u>literally</u> since no one has <u>purple hair?</u>
- 5. What does it mean to be "held" in the "galleries"?
- 6. What does "Carmel" mean?

Song of Solomon 7:5

"Thine head upon thee is like Carmel, and the hair of thine head like purple; the King is held in the galleries".

Think about the Physical

Solomon is describing a beautiful <u>woman</u> in Chapter 7. In this verse: 5 he is concentrating on <u>her **head**</u> and the **hair** of her **head**. He says her <u>head</u> is like "Carmel" and her <u>hair</u> like "purple".


No **real woman** has purple hair so it is a <u>Spiritual Woman</u> or <u>Church</u> he is describing! (*ISA. 54 : 5,6 REV. 19 : 7,8*).

Determine their Spiritual Meaning

The "head" of the Church is Jesus (EPHESIANS 5:23)



HEAD = LEADER

MICAH

9 Hear this, I pray you, ye heads of the house of Jacob, and princes of the house of Israel, that abhor judgment, and pervert all equity.

PSALM 110 he shall wound the heads over many countries.

Then, **Jesus** (the "head") is pictured as being like "<u>Carmel</u>" so we need to know what the Bible means by "Carmel" as we compare the <u>Scriptures</u> and the <u>Hebrew</u>.

Carmel

1 Kings 18: 19 says that "Carmel" is a mountain.

Joshua 15:55 says that "Carmel" is a town.

The Hebrew word for "Carmel" (# 3759, 3760 - <u>KARMEL</u>) means <u>fruitful field or place</u> and that it was a <u>town</u> and <u>hill</u> in Palestine.

The margin of the KJV Bible says that "Carmel" means **Crimson** or deep blood **red** (# 3758).

2 Chronicles 2:7 says that the Crimson (red) of the Sanctuary curtains are Karmiyl (# 3758) and the Hebrew letters and word spelling is very similar between # 3760 and # 3758.

Thus, the translators felt that the meaning of **Crimson** or **red** could be meant in this verse rather than the "standard" meaning of "fruitful place or hill" and so translated the Hebrew word "<u>Karmel</u>" into English as "**Carmel**".

Thus "<u>Carmel</u>" could represent a <u>mountain</u>, a <u>town</u>, a <u>fruitful</u> <u>place</u> or the <u>color Red</u>. Before deciding <u>which</u> meaning to use let us go on and examine the rest of the <u>context</u> of the verse.

The "<u>hair</u>" of the <u>head</u> of the <u>woman</u> or "head" of the <u>Church</u> or of <u>Jesus</u> is described as being "<u>like **purple**</u>".

<u>hair</u> (# 1803) – hair, something dangling (so the verse <u>is</u> talking about the "<u>hair</u>") <u>purple</u> (# 713) - the color <u>purple</u> (so, it really means the <u>color purple</u> in Hebrew)

Thus, the <u>translation</u> is a good one.

It says that the "hair" of the woman is like the color purple.

The Spiritual meaning of the word "hair" is a covering.

1 Corinthians 11:15 "But if a woman have long <u>hair</u>, it is a glory to her: for her <u>hair</u> is given her for a **covering**".

Another word for "a covering" is a garment.

(So, the "hair" or the <u>covering</u> or the <u>garment</u> of the <u>head</u> of the <u>woman</u> or the "<u>head" of the **Church** is "**purple**". In other words the Bible text is saying that "the <u>garment</u> of **Jesus** is **purple**".</u>

The color **purple** was the color worn by **Kings**.

Judges 8: 26 "...and <u>purple</u> raiment that was on the <u>Kings</u> of Midian".

(So, the verse is saying that the "head" of the woman or Head of the Church will be a **King** and will wear the **purple** garment of <u>Royalty</u>.

<u>Purple</u> was also the color of the **rich**.

Luke 16: 19 "There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen,...".

Lets check and see if <u>Jesus</u> (the "head" or <u>king</u>) fulfilled these predictions.

Mark 15:17,18 "And they <u>clothed</u> him with **purple** and plaited a crown of thorns, and put it about his head, And began to salute him, Hail, **King** of the Jews!'.

(Yes, **Jesus** our **King** was clothed in **purple**!).

2 Cor 8:9 "For ye know the grace of our Lord **Jesus** Christ, that, though he was **rich**, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich".

Isaiah 53: 9 "And he <u>made his grave</u> with the wicked and with the <u>rich</u> in his death..."

Mat 27: 57-60 "...a rich man..named Joseph went to Pilate and begged the body of <u>Jesus</u> and when Joseph had taken the body, he <u>wrapped it</u> in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in <u>his own new tomb</u> which had hewn out in the rock.

(Yes, <u>Jesus</u> our <u>King</u> was <u>rich</u> and buried with the <u>rich</u> as predicted by the Bible).

The next part of the verse says "... the <u>King</u> is <u>held</u> in the galleries".

The word "<u>held</u>" (# 631 - to <u>fasten</u> in any sense, to <u>bind</u>, put in bonds, tie).

The KJV margin says "bound".

(So, the verse is saying the <u>King</u> was to be "<u>bound</u>" or "<u>tied up</u>").

Matthew 27:2 "And when they had bound him, they led him away and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor".

(So <u>Jesus</u> was "tied up" or "bound" as a capture).

When a person died they were "bound" in graveclothes.

John 11:44 "And he that was <u>dead</u> came forth, <u>bound</u> hand and foot with graveclothes and his face was <u>bound</u> about with a napkin...".

Mark 15:46"... and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulcher which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulcher".

(So, the text is predicting that **Jesus** would be "bound" or "wrapped" in graveclothes.

Checking the word "King" (# 4428 - a king, Royal), it is a good translation and means "king".

The verse said "... the king is held in the "galleries".

Lets see what the word "galleries" means.

"galleries" (# 7298 – to hollow out, a channel, like a ringlet of hair).

There are 3 other places in the Bible that the word "galleries" is used. They <u>all</u> have a different Hebrew word (# 862), so we get not help there.

Our 3 choices then for the meaning of the word "galleries" in our text (to hollow out, a channel, a ringlet hair) all point to something being hollow or having a hole in it.

Thus, the text is saying that the king (Jesus) was held (bound) in the galleries (hollowed out place).

(So, the text is predicting that <u>King</u> Jesus would be <u>bound</u> in graveclothes and placed in a <u>hollowed out</u> tomb).

This actually happened as recorded in (*Matthew 27:57-60*) *57* "When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathea named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus disciple: *58* He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. *59* And when Joseph had taken the body, he <u>wrapped</u> it in a clean linen cloth, *60* And laid it in his own new <u>tomb</u> which he had <u>hewn out</u> in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulcher, and departed".

Now, returning to the word "**Carmel**" we find that word could mean: mountain or hill, town, fruitful place or the color red.

In the **context** of the <u>rest of the verse</u>:

- 1. The "covering" or garment of <u>Jesus</u> to be **purple**.
- 2. Jesus to be a "King".
- 3. Jesus to be "rich" and buried with the rich.
- 4. Jesus to be "bound" and wrapped in graveclothes.
- 5. Jesus to be placed in a "hollowed out" tomb.

It seems clear that the meaning of "Carmel" as "red" is the <u>best</u> <u>fit</u>, since "red" is associated with **blood** and <u>death</u> which is the main subject of the verse,

2 King 3:22 "...as <u>red</u> as <u>blood</u>".

Revelation 7:14 "... the blood of the Lamb".

"...John seeth <u>Jesus</u> coming. unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God..."

SUMMARY

Thus this verse, *Song of Solomon 7:5* is a <u>prophecy</u> predicting the **death** of "**King**" <u>Jesus</u>, who would be "**tied up**" or bound and tried in a court and then would shed His **blood** (red) and be **wrapped** or "bound" in graveclothes and placed in a "**hollowed out**" **tomb** (galleries) with the **rich**.

Song of Solomon 7:5

"Thine <u>head</u> upon thee is like <u>Carmel</u>, and the <u>hair</u> of thine <u>head</u> like <u>purple</u>; the <u>King</u> is <u>held</u> in the <u>galleries</u>".

Paraphrase

The Head of the Church, **Jesus** Christ, will shed His **blood** and the **covering** of Jesus will be the **purple** robe of a **King**: King Jesus will be **bound** in graveclothes and placed in a <u>hollowed out</u> **tomb**.

FULFILLMENT OF THE ABOVE PROPHECY : Mark 15: 1, 17, 46

Mark 15:1 "And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and <u>bound</u> Jesus, and carried him away, and delivered him to Pilate".

Mark 15:17 "And they <u>clothed him with **purple**</u>, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his head".

Mark 15: 46 "And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulcher which hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulcher".

A GOOD NAME IS BETTER THAN

A GOOD **name** *is* better than <u>precious **ointment**</u>; and <u>the day of **death** than <u>the day of one's **birth**</u>. (Ecclesiastes 7:1)</u>

QUESTIONS:

1 What is the <u>Spiritual</u> significance of "name"?

A person's Spiritual "name" represents his character.

Exodus 34:5 And the Lord descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the **name** of the Lord. **6** And the Lord passed by before him, and <u>proclaimed</u>, The Lord, The Lord God, **merciful** and **gracious**, **longsuffering**, and abundant in **goodness** and **truth**.

2 Does the Bible verse really mean that a "good **name**" is **better** than "<u>precious **ointment**</u>", or is it simply making a **comparison** so that we will see the **value**?

It is making a comparison.

Song of Solomon 1: 3 Because of the **savour** of thy good ointments thy **name** *is as* ointment poured forth, therefore do the virgins love thee.

3 How can it be **better** to "**die**" than to be "**born**"?

It <u>cannot</u> mean <u>Physical</u> "death" but rather <u>Spiritual</u> "death", or "dying to sin" or becoming "converted".

- 4 Is the verse speaking of <u>Physical</u> "death" or <u>Spiritual</u> "death"? Spiritual "death".
- 5 Is the verse speaking of Physical "birth" or Spiritual "birth"?

If a <u>contrast</u> is meant, then it is <u>better</u> to <u>Spiritually</u> "**die** to sin", than to be <u>Physically</u> "**born**" into the world. If a <u>comparison</u> is meant, then the day of **Spiritual death** (dying to sin or CONVERSION) is like being **Spiritually** "**born**" <u>again</u>.

Ecclesiastes 7:1

A GOOD **name** (*CHARACTER*) is better than <u>precious **ointment**</u> (*PERFUME*) and the <u>day of **death**</u> (*SPIRITUAL* <u>DEATH</u> or **CONVERSION**) than the <u>day of one's **birth**</u>. (*PHYSICAL* <u>BIRTH</u>).

4. RE-WRITE THE VERSE: <u>Substitute the Spiritual Meaning</u> of the Key Words <u>back into the Bible verse</u> and <u>RE-WRITE</u> it to discover what God is saying to us <u>Spiritually</u>!

PARAPHRASE

- A good Character (Spiritual name) is better than Physically smelling good (Physical OINTMENT); and the day of our Conversion (Spiritual DEATH to sin), is better than the day we were Physically born.
- ② A good Character (Spiritual name) is like a person filled with the Holy Spirit (PRECIOUS OINTMENT or OIL) who seeks to do Righteousness (PRECIOUS OINTMENT), and the day they were Converted or "died to sin" (Spiritual death) was the day they experienced the "new birth" (Spiritual birth) and began a new RIGHTEOUS life.

- 2 The **Lord** made a man but the <u>man</u> made a <u>mistake</u> so the Lord made him into **another man**.

Jer 18: 6

O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the Lord. Behold as the <u>clay</u> is <u>in the potters hand</u>, so are <u>ye</u> <u>in mine hand</u>, O house of Israel.

- 1 As the potter takes clay in his hand to form it, so the Lord can take His people and change them.
- 2 The Lord can change people.

Bible Quote

Lam 4: 2

The precious sons of Zion, comparable to fine gold, how they are they esteemed as earthen pitchers, the work of the hands of the potter.

Zech 11: 13

And the <u>Lord said</u> unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that <u>I was praised</u> at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the Lord.

Rom 9: 21

Hath not the <u>potter</u> power over the clay, of the <u>same lump</u> to make <u>one vessel unto honor</u>, and another unto <u>dishonor</u>?

Rev 2: 27

And He shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the <u>vessels</u> of a <u>potter</u> shall they be <u>broken</u> to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

Own Words 1 Literal meaning 2 Spiritual meaning

- 1 The people of God, the work of the hands of the potter, are as valuable as gold to Him, but to others they are as worthles as clay pitchers.
 - 2 When the <u>Lord</u> changes us we are of <u>great</u> value to Him but worthless to others.
- 1 The potter himself was only valued at thirty pieces of silver by his own people.
- 2 The Lord Himself was <u>not</u> of <u>great value</u> to His people. They <u>sold Him</u> for 30 pieces of silver in His own Temple!
- 1 From the same lump of clay the potter has made vessels which will bring him honor and others that will dishonor Him.
- 2 The Lord has made us all. Some people will allow Him to change them and they will bring Him honor, but others will not allow Him to change them and they will bring Him dishonor.
- 1 The <u>potter</u> will <u>break</u> into pieces some of the <u>vessels</u> he has made.
- 2 The **Lord** will **destroy** the **people** who bring Him <u>dishonor</u>.

Now go back and <u>read</u> the **Spiritual Meaning** of each verse and you will see the **STORY** that the Bible has been telling you. Then, turn the page and see the STORY that I have written.

Potter

The Story that the Bible tells us about the "Word" POTTER.

Literal Story:

The potter treads the clay. The Lord is the potter and we are the clay. The potter made a vessel of clay but it became flawed so the potter made it into another vessel. As the potter takes clay in his hand to form it, so the Lord can take His people and change them. The people of God, the work of the hands of the potter, are as valuable as gold to Him, but to others they are as worthless as clay pitchers. The potter himself was only valued at 30 pieces of silver. From the same lump of clay the potter makes vessels of which some will bring him honer and some will bring dishoner. The potter will break in pieces some of the vessels he has made.

Spiritual Story:

The Lord is the potter and we are the clay. The Lord has power over the people just like potter has power over the clay. The Lord made a man from the clay of the earth but the man made a mistake. Just as a potter can take the clay and make a new vessel out of it, the Lord can take a man that has made a mistake and change him into a new man. A person that God has changed is very valuable to Him, but to others he is as worthless as a clay pitcher. The Lord Himself was not of value to his own people. They sold Him for only 30 pieces of silver, the price of a slave. Just as a potter takes the same lump of clay and makes some vessels that will bring him honor and others that will bring him dishonor, so the Lord has made all men from the clay of the earth and some men will bring Him honor and others will bring Him dishonor. The Lord will rule over all men and He will destroy those who bring Him dishonor.

Aaron The High Priest Proclaims a Feast Day

Exo 32.1 And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

Exo 32:2 And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them unto me. Exo 32:3 And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears,

and brought them unto Aaron.

Exo 32:4 And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, these be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Exo 32:5 And when <u>Aaron</u> saw it, he <u>built an altar</u> before it; and <u>Aaron made</u>

proclamation, and said, to morrow is a feast to the LORD.

In order to understand this "Acted Parable" we will first think about the Physical:

A (physical) man made a (physical) image of a beast for the people to worship and then proclaimed a time to worship the (physical) image of the beast.

Now we will think about the Spiritual:

A (spiritual) man made a (spiritual) image of a beast for the people to worship and then proclaimed a time to worship the (spiritual) image of the beast.

Remembering what Paul said about all the things that happened to the children of Israel:

1Cor.10:11 "Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples(models) and they are written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come.

We conclude then, that in the last days a similar event will happen. Thus:

A spiritual <u>man</u> will make a spiritual <u>image</u> for people to worship and will proclaim a <u>time to worship</u> the spiritual <u>image</u>.

We recall from the <u>book of Revelation</u> a warning message from God for those living in the last days:

Rev.13:9,10 "And the third angel followed them saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast or his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture.."

The similarity between the "Acted Parable" and this Bible verse is unmistakeable. Therefore we need to carefully study the "Acted Parable" to see what we can learn to prepare us for the events of the last days.

The "Acted Parable" of Aaron the High Priest

EXO 19:1 In the <u>third month</u>, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came <u>they into the wilderness of Sinai</u>.

EXO 19:2 For they were departed from Rephidim, and were come to the desert of Sinai, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount.

EXO 24:18 And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and gat him up into the mount: and Moses was in the mount forty days and forty nights.

EXO 31:18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

EXO 32:1 And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

EXO 32:2 And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them unto me.

EXO 32:3 And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them unto Aaron.

EXO 32:4 And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

EXO 32:5 And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to the LORD.

We recall that God Himself gave Moses the "feasts of the Lord" that the children of Israel were to keep.

These are clearly listed in Leviticus 23. We will "Compare Scripture with Scripture" to see what we can learn.

Comparing Scripture with Scripture

LEV 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

LEV 23:5 In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD'S passover.

LEV 23:6 And on the <u>fifteenth day of the same month</u> is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

LEV 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation. LEV 23:25 Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

LEV 23:27 Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

LEV 23:34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The <u>fifteenth day of this seventh month</u> shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.

LEV 23:37 These are the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon his day:

LEV 23:38 Beside the sabbaths of the LORD, and beside your gifts, and beside all your vows, and beside all your freewill offerings, which ye give unto the LORD.

From Lev.23:

We learn that God set the times for worship as:

Passover	14th day of	1st month
Unleavened bread	15th-21st day of	1st month
Blowing of trumpets	1st day	7th month
Day of Atonement	10th day	7th month
Feast of Tabernacles	15th-21st day	7th month
Sabbath	7th day	weekly

From Exodus:

We learn that Aaron(a man) set the time for worship as:

Ex.19:1,2 Israel in wilderness at Sinai 3rd month

Ex. 24:18 Moses into Mt. Sinai(40 days)+40 days

Ex. 31:18, 31:1-4 Moses given 10 Com.

by God and while still in the Mt.

Aaron makes the image of the beast

Ex.32:5 Aaron proclaims "tomorrow is a feast to the Lord"

Therefore the timing of **Aaron's** "day of worship" is

3rd month +40days = 4th month

Summary

The <u>only times</u> for worship set by God were to occur during the 1st or 7th months or weekly on the 7th day of the week. Aaron's proclaimed day of worship occurred during the 4th month. Thus, we conclude that Aaron set up <u>his own</u> "time of worship" thus <u>changing</u> the <u>time of worship</u> that God had established!

Conclusions:

This "Acted Parable" is warning us that in the <u>Last Days</u> a man will attempt to establish a <u>time of worship</u> that will be <u>different from the time of worship</u> established by God.

Aaron made an image of a golden calf and then caused the people to worship it. This is called "idolatry" by the Bible. "Idolatry" is making an "image" or likeness of something and then using it in worship. (Exodus 20:4-6) Thus this "Acted Parable" is warning us that a man will make an "image" or likeness of Gods Time of Worship and will then cause the people to worship at the time he has set up.

If we worship the "image" of God's Time of worship that has been set up by a man, then we will be committing idolatry.

God's Time of Worship

Ex.20:10,11
But the <u>seventh day</u> is the <u>sabbath</u> of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For <u>in six days</u> the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and <u>rested the seventh day</u>: wherefore the <u>Lord blessed the sabbath day</u>, and hallowed it.

The **Image** in the **Bed**

The "Acted Parable

Bible Verse: 1 Samuel 19: 13-17 "And Michal took an image, and laid it in the bed, and put a pillow of goat's hair for his bolster, and covered it with a cloth. And when Saul sent messengers to take David, she said, He is sick. And Saul sent the messengers again to see David, saying, bring him up to me in the bed that I may slay him. An when the messengers were come in, behold, there was an image in the bed, with a pillow of goat's hair for his bolster. And Saul said unto Michal, why hast thou deceived me so, and sent away mine enemy, that he is escaped? And Michal answered Saul, he said unto me, let me go; why should I kill thee?"

In order to understand this "Acted Parable" we will first think about the **Physical**:

A (physical) <u>woman</u> took a (physical) <u>image</u> or <u>idol</u> and placed it in a (physical) <u>bed</u> in order to (physically) <u>deceive</u> people. The (physical) "<u>head</u>" of the (physical) <u>image</u> was a (physical) <u>goat</u>.

Now we will think about the Spiritual:

A (spiritual) <u>woman</u> took a (spiritual) <u>image</u> and placed it in a (spiritual) <u>bed</u> in order to (spiritual) <u>deceive</u> people. The (spiritual) <u>"head"</u> of the (spiritual) <u>image</u> was a (spiritual) goat.

Remembering what Paul said about all the things that happened to the children of Israel: *1 Corinthians 10:11* "Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples (models) and they are written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come".

We conclude then, that **in the last days** a similar event will happen. Thus a (spiritual) <u>woman</u> will take a (spiritual) <u>image</u> and <u>put it</u> in a <u>place</u> of (spiritual) <u>rest</u> (<u>bed</u>) and this will <u>deceive</u> people.

COMMENTS:

In order to understand the Spiritual meaning of this "Acted Parable" we need to <u>locate</u> the **Key Words** and <u>discover</u> their **Spiritual Meanings**.

Bible Verse: 1 Samuel 19: 13-17"And Michal took an image, and laid it in the bed, and put a pillow of goat's hair for his bolster, and covered it with a cloth. And when Saul sent messengers to take David, she said, He is sick. And Saul sent the messengers again to see David, saying, bring him up to me in the bed that I may slay him. An when the messengers were come in, behold, there was an image in the bed, with a pillow of goat's hair for his bolster. Locate **Key Words**in the verse: (usually nouns or "real things") Woman (she, Michal) *Image (# 8655 - idol) Bed (place of physical rest) Goat Bolster (# 4763 - head) Deceived (# 7411)

A bed has only two functions:

1. It is a <u>place</u> of **rest** (*Isaiah 57:2*)

2. It is a place of **relationship** (*Ezekiel 23:17*)

A physical **bed** would provide:

- 1. A place of physical rest
- 2. A <u>place</u> of physical **relationship**


A spiritual **bed** would provide:

- 1. A place of spiritual rest
- 2. A <u>place</u> of spiritual **relationship**


The <u>Bible</u> only speaks of <u>God</u> having <u>one "**place**" of **rest**.</u>

Hebrews 4: 4,5 "For he spake in a certain place of the <u>seventh day</u> on this wise and <u>God</u> did **rest** the <u>seventh day</u> from all his work. And in this place again, if they shall **enter into** <u>my rest</u>".

Thus, God's one "place" of rest or His "bed" is the seventh day Sabbath.

What will the Main (Spiritual) thought be about?

A (spiritual) <u>woman</u> took a (spiritual) <u>image</u> and placed it in a (spiritual) <u>bed</u> in order to (spiritually) <u>deceive</u> people. The (spiritual) "head" of the (spiritual) image was a (spiritual) goat.

PARAPHRASE:

A false church (woman) took a spiritual "image" or likeness of rest (Sunday) and put it in the place of God's Time of Rest(7th day Sabbath)(bed) in order to spiritually deceive people. The spiritual "head" behind this deception was Satan (goat).

CONCLUSIONS

This "Acted Parable" is warning us that in the <u>Last Days</u> a **Church** will attempt to **establish** a <u>time of worship</u> that will be <u>different</u> from the <u>time of worship</u> **established by God**.

Aaron, the <u>highest</u> of the priests, made an **image** of a golden calf and then caused the people to <u>worship it</u>. This is called "<u>idolatry</u>" by the Bible. "**Idolatry**" is making an "<u>image</u>" or likeness of something and then using it in worship. (*Exodus 20 : 4-6*).



The **Sunday**, as a day of the week set apart for the obligatory public **worship** of Almighty God; to be sanctified by a suspension of all servile labor, trade, and worldly avocations and by exercises of devotion, is **purely** a **creation** of the **Catholic Church**.

The Sunday laws are in their origin a part of the Catholic system enforced by the state when Europe was Catholic. <u>The day and the regulations have no logical basis except the authority of the Catholic Church</u>.

<u>In the primitive days</u> of fervor and piety all days were so consecrated by exercises of devotion that <u>no special command for the sanctification of the first</u> day is traced.

This became gradually obligatory, although the command was not at first peremptory. The Council of Laodicea, in 364 A.D, defines: "That Christians must not Judaize and refrain from manual labor on Saturday, but work on that day; and that, preferring the Lord's day, they must then rest, if this can be done, as becomes Christians".

The Church thus began by calling her children to sanctify the first day of the week, that on which God the Son rose from the dead, that, on which God the Father began the creation of the world, and God the Holy Ghost descended on the Apostles. She commanded a laying aside of business, a refraining from servile work, as a means to the end she had in view, the sanctification of the day.

<u>Constantine</u> lent the <u>power of the state</u> to <u>enforce</u> the <u>regulations</u> of the <u>Church</u>, and the <u>civil law</u> began to <u>enforce</u> the <u>spiritual decrees</u>. <u>He commanded the Lord's day to be observed by all</u> as a festival and <u>day of rest</u>.

Protestantism, in discarding the authority of the Church, **has no good_reason** for its **Sunday theory**, and ought, logically, to **keep Saturday** as the **Sabbath**, with the Jews and Seventh-Day Baptists.

The Defiled Bed Genesis 49

- 1 And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days.
- 2 Gather yourselves together, and hear, ye sons of Jacob; and hearken unto Israel your father.
- 3 Reuben, thou *art* my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:
- 4 Unstable as water, thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's **bed**; then <u>defiledst</u> thou <u>it</u>: he went up to my <u>couch</u>.

GENESIS 49

which shall befall you in the last days.

Keyword: last #319-the last or end, future
Thus, in this chapter of the Bible, God, reveals
the future for us, because Israels sons would
not be living at the end of time or the "last days".

Gal. 4: 28, 29
28 Now <u>we</u>, brethren, as <u>Isaac was</u>, <u>are</u> the <u>children of promise</u>.
29 And if <u>ye</u> be <u>Christ's</u>, then are <u>ye</u> <u>Abraham's seed</u>, and <u>heirs according</u> to the promise.

As Isaac was the "child of promise", so those that believe in Jesus (Christlans) are the "children of promise". They are (Israelites) and they are "Abraham's seed" and heirs of the promises of God.

Thus, the "children of Israel" represent "the Church", meaning all Christian denominations.

"Israel" represents Catholics, Baptists, Methodists, etc.

1Cor.10:11 "Now all these things happened unto them (children of Israel) for ensamples and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come."

Strongs' Concordance gives the meaning for ensample from the Greek as: a model for warning, a type, a figure #5179 tupos(from #5180 tupto) #5180 tupto repeated blows

Thus, the characteristics of the "children of Israel" and events that happened to them, represent models of things to be repeated and spiritual events to happen to the Church in the "last days".

3 ¶ Reuben, thou art my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

Keyword: firstborn

The term "firstborn" had a dual meaning:

- 1. To be the oldest son or son born first. NUM 1:20
- 2. To be the one upon whom the blessings of God were especially given to. (GEN 48:18.20)

Thus, in this prophecy of last day events, "Reuben" represents a part of the "Church" that dates back to the begining of the history of the church in chronological time.

"Reuben" also represents a part of the "Church" that would receive great blessings from God and because of these blessings would excel in strength and power.

The Bible, in the New Testament, tells us that in the beginning the Christian Church was filled with the power of the Holy Spirit as it went to all the world.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me.. unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Thus, in its beginning and in its purity, the Church was filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.

But soon, a change would take place in the Church

4 Unstable as water, thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's bed; then defiledst thou *it*: he went up to my couch.

Thus, the Bible predicted that the Church would become "unstable as water" and would "not excel".

Rev. 17:15 tells us that "water" represents people. "..the waters which thou sawest,..are peoples.."

As people began to put their ideas instead of God's ideas into the Church, it began to CHANGE

Gen.49:4 predicts that the Church would fall from power ("not excel") and gives the reason why

"..thou shalt <u>not excel</u>; <u>because</u> thou wentest up to <u>thy father's bed</u>; then <u>defiledst thou it</u>..."

The <u>Father's place of rest</u> would be <u>defiled</u> by the <u>Church!!!</u>

The Spiritual "Bed" of the Bible

God (the Father) has a "BED" or (place of "REST"): Isa.66:1 Thus saith the Lord...where is the place of my rest? Lukel 1:7 ..my children are with me in bed;...

In a spiritual marriage "relationship":

A (spiritual) "BED" plays an important role:

A (spr)BED provides: a place of (spr)REST

A (spr)BED provides: a place of (spr)Relationship

God's "BED" or the "Father's place of REST":

Ex.31:15 Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the Lord...

God's "BED" or the "Father's place of Relationship":

Ex.31:16,17 ..keep the sabbath..for a perpetual covenant it is a sign between me and..Israel forever:

Thus, the Bible has predicted that the <u>Father's place of "rest"</u> or <u>God's "BED"</u> (which is the <u>7th-day SABBATH</u>), would be "<u>defiled</u>" or <u>CHANGED</u> by <u>PEOPLE</u> in the <u>Church</u>!!! Gen.49:4

"..thou shalt <u>not excel</u>; <u>because</u> thou wentest up to <u>thy father's bed</u>; then <u>defiledst thou it</u>:.."

Now, lets see what God thinks about that CHANGE.

1Chr.5:1 Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel, (for he was the firstborn:) but forasmuch as he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given unto the sons of Joseph the son of Israel: and the genealogy is not to be reckoned after the birthright.

Thus, the <u>birthright blessing of God</u> was <u>REMOVED</u> from <u>the CHURCH</u> when it <u>CHANGED</u> or <u>defiled the SABBATH</u> and <u>it was GIVEN</u> to another part of the <u>CHURCH</u> that <u>would come later</u> represented by "<u>Joseph</u>".

Thus, the Bible has predicted: the "defiling" or changing of God's 7th-day Sabbath by the Christian Church and that God's birthright blessing would be removed from the Church that made the change.

History clearly tells us that the Roman Catholic Church has "defiled" the Sabbath of the Lord by changing the day of worship from:

the 7th day(Saturday) to the 1st day(Sunday)

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Gen.49:4 "..thou shalt <u>not excel</u>; <u>because</u> thou wentest up to <u>thy father's bed</u>; then <u>defiledst thou it</u>..."

The Hebrew word used for "defiledst" in the above Bible verse is unique. This is the only place in the entire Bible that this word is used!!

Keyword: <u>defiledst</u>
Strongs # 2490 -to <u>profane</u>
(a person, place, or thing)

The "BED" was:

profaned (treated with irreverence, made common or unholy, desecrated and polluted, put to an unworthy use, made secular as opposed to sacred)

(Note: All meanings for the word profane taken from Funk and Wagnalls New Practical Standard Dictionary)

Remember that the "BED" represents

The Father's place of rest, God's 7th-day Sabbath The <u>False Church</u> has a <u>"BED"</u> or (place of rest) Rev. 2:20...thou sufferest that <u>woman Jezebel</u>,..to teach and seduce my servants..

Rev. 2:22,23 Behold, I will <u>cast her</u> into a <u>bed</u>, and them that <u>commit adultery with her</u> into great tribulation...

The False Church wants us to:

"Remember" her Bed (place of rest)(1st day Sunday)

Isa.57:7 Upon a lofty and high mountain hast thou set thy **bed**:..

Isa.57:8 Behind the doors and posts hast thou set up thy remembrance: for thou hast discovered thyself to another than me, and art gone up; thou hast enlarged thy bed and made a covenant with them; thou lovest their bed where thou sawest it.

Our <u>Creator God</u> wants us to: "Remember"His Bed (place of rest)(7th day Sabbath)

The 4th Commandment:

Ex.20:8-11 Remember the <u>sabbath day</u> to keep <u>it holy</u>. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:
But the <u>seventh day</u> is the <u>sabbath of the Lord thy God</u>:

..For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

(The seventh day is Saturday not Sunday)

The Foxes Have Holes

THE FOXES HAVE HOLES AND THE BIRDS HAVE NESTS

DISCOVERING HIDDEN TREASURE

BIBLE VERSE:

MAT 8:19 And a certain scribe came, and said unto him, Master, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.

MAT 8:20 And Jesus saith unto him, The <u>foxes</u> have <u>holes</u>, and the <u>birds</u> of the air have <u>nests</u>; but the Son of man <u>hath not where to lay his</u> head.

COMPARING THE SCRIPTURES:

In order to determine what it means to "follow thee whithersoever...." we will compare scripture with scripture using the keyword "follow".

Rev 14: 4 "..these are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth.."

1Kings 18: 21 "And Elijah came unto all the people and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? If the Lord be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word."

Isa 51:1 " Hearken to me; ye that follow after righteousnes, ye that seek the Lord.."

Hosea 6: 3 "Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord..."

Matt 16: 24 "Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny self, and take up his cross and follow me."

<u>1Peter 2: 21</u> "For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us and example, that ye <u>follow</u> his steps: who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth." <u>Conclusions:</u>

- 1. To "follow" Jesus means: To do whatever Jesus does or says to do.
- The scribes declaration to "do whatever Jesus says" is addressed by Jesus in the Acted Parable of the foxes and birds and his answer is pertinent to the scribes declaration.
- Just as the scribe was <u>not talking about physically following</u> Jesus but <u>spiritually following him</u>, so also we would expect <u>Jesus answer</u> to <u>concern spiritual things</u> rather than just physical things.

MAT 8:20 And Jesus saith unto him, The <u>foxes</u> have <u>holes</u>, and the <u>birds</u> of the air have <u>nests</u>; but the Son of man <u>hath not where to lay his</u> head.

THINK ABOUT THE PHYSICAL:

On the surface of the Acted Parable Jesus contrasts His situation with the situation of foxes and birds.

He says that both of them <u>have something</u> that He <u>doesn't have</u>. Since Jesus specifically says that he "hath <u>not</u> where <u>to lay his head</u>" the <u>main subject</u> that he is talking about <u>concerns sleep</u> or <u>rest</u>.

In keeping with Jesus method of using <u>physical things</u> to represent <u>spiritual things</u>, we would expect then that Jesus is <u>really talking</u> about <u>Spiritual Rest</u> rather than physical rest.

Similarly, we would also expect the <u>other physical objects</u> (foxes, birds, holes, nests) in the Acted Parable to have <u>spiritual meanings</u>.

Thus:

the physical fox = a spiritual fox the physical bird= a spiritual bird the physical hole= a spiritual hole the physical nest= a spiritual nest

The way to determine these spiritual meanings is not to speculate, but to let the Bible itself explain the meanings by comparing scripture with scripture.

THINK ABOUT THE SPIRITUAL:

We will first <u>confirm</u> that there is a <u>connection in the Bible</u> between Jesus statement to "<u>lay his head</u>" and <u>physical rest</u> and then we will determine if there is a relation between physical and spiritual rest.

Keyword: lay

Gen 28:10, 11 "And Jacob..took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and <u>lay</u> (#7901) down in that place to sleep."

#7901-to lie down for rest or sexual connection

This text shows us that it was common for men to use stones for pillows or stones for a place to "lay their head". Jesus could have always found real stones to lay his head on if he wanted to. This shows that it was not physical rest, but spiritual rest that Jesus had lost.

Keyword: pillow

Mark 4: 38 " And he (Jesus) was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow..."

Keyword: sleep

Matt 26: 45 "Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, sleep on now and take your rest:..."

John 11: 13 "Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking <u>rest</u> in <u>sleep</u>."

The above texts show that the Bible uses the words <u>sleep</u> or <u>rest</u> or to "<u>lay down your head</u>" interchangeably. Thus the statement by Jesus could be paraphrased to say: "The Son of man <u>hath not where to rest</u>", and once again we must conclude that Jesus was talking about <u>Spiritual Rest</u>, and not just physical rest because he could always find a stone for his head to lay on.

Keyword: rest

Heb 4: 4, 9-11 "For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did <u>rest</u> the seventh day from all his works." ... "There remaineth therefore a <u>rest</u> to the people of God. For he that is entered into his <u>rest</u>, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. Let us labor therefore to enter into that <u>rest</u>, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief."

Thus, the <u>Spiritual Rest</u> of God and Jesus and his people is the <u>7th day Sabbath Rest</u> that memorializes the <u>finishing of Creation</u>.

With this in mind, then in the Acted Parable of the foxes and birds, Jesus must be saying that His 7th day Sabbath rest would be lost!

On the next page we will examine the <u>relationship of the foxes and birds</u> and their holes and nests, to the **lost Sabbath Rest** of Jesus.

Keyword: foxes

Ezk 13: 3, 4 "Thus saith the Lord God; Woe unto the <u>foolish prophets</u>, that follow their own spirit and have seen nothing!

O Israel, thy <u>prophets</u> are like the <u>foxes</u> in the deserts."

Thus, the Bible uses "foxes" to represent false prophets.

Keyword: birds

Prov 27: 8 "As a <u>bird</u> that wandereth from her nest, so is a <u>man</u> that wandereth from his place."

Lam 3: 52 "Mine enemies chase me sore, like a bird, without cause."

Thus, the Bible uses "birds" to represent men.

SUMMARY:

It is clear that in the Bible <u>"foxes"</u> represent <u>false prophets</u> and <u>"birds"</u> represent <u>men.</u> In Matt 8: 20 the context of the scripture and <u>what the "birds" are doing</u> (making a nest), parallels the action of the "foxes"(making a hole), and the "foxes" represent <u>false prophets</u>. Therefore, it is reasonable to assume that the "birds" in the verse represent <u>wicked men.</u>

Now let us examine what the Bible says about "holes".

Keyword: holes

Isa 7: 19 "And they shall come, and shall <u>rest</u> all of them in the desolate valleys, and in the <u>holes</u> of the rocks.."

Isa 42: 22 "But this is a people robbed and spoiled; they are all of them snared in holes.."

Thus "rest" and being snared or trapped is associated by the Bible with "holes".

THINK ABOUT THE PHYSICAL:

THE FOX MAKES A HOLE

When a real or physical fox digs a physical hole, he removes existing physical material in order to make a place of physical rest for himself.

Thus, the Acted Parable presents the picture of "spiritual foxes" or false prophets who have removed existing spiritual material or removed part of Gods Word in order to make a place of spiritual rest for themselves.

THE BIRD MAKES A NEST

When a real or <u>physical bird</u> makes a <u>physical nest</u>, it <u>gathers <u>physical materials</u> like branches, grass, and mud and puts them together in order to make a <u>new</u> place of <u>physical rest</u> for itself.</u>

Thus, the Acted Parable presents the picture of "spiritual birds" or spiritual men (ministers) who have gathered spiritual materials and have put them together in order to make a new place of spiritual rest for themselves.

Now, we will Summarize our findings and draw our Final Conclusions.

FINAL SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS:

We discovered that when the scribe declared to Jesus, "I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest", he meant that he would "do whatever Jesus said to do". We then concluded that Jesus response to him had to do directly with "following Him spiritually", or "doing what He says"!

By comparing what the foxes and birds <u>had</u>, to what Jesus did <u>not have</u>, we concluded that the foxes and birds <u>had</u> a <u>place to rest</u>, while Jesus had <u>no place to rest</u>.

Thus, <u>Jesus response</u> to the scribes declaration that he would <u>"do whatever Jesus said to do"</u> has to do with the <u>"rest"</u> of the "foxes and birds" and the <u>missing "rest"</u> of Jesus.

After examining the statement by Jesus that he "hath not where to <u>lay his head</u>" we concluded that since Jesus <u>had</u> the availability of <u>real objects</u> such as stones, pillows, etc to lay his head on, that he must be talking about <u>spiritual rest</u> rather than <u>physical rest</u>. By comparing the scriptures, we discovered that the "<u>spiritual rest</u>" of Jesus is the <u>7th day Sabbath Rest</u>.

Thus, the <u>response of Jesus</u> to the scribes declaration that he would "do whatever Jesus said to do", concerns:

the missing 7th day Sabbath Rest of Jesus and the spiritual "rest" that the "foxes and birds" have made for themselves.

By comparing the scriptures we discovered that the "foxes" represented false prophets and that the "birds" represented men.

Thus, the <u>response of Jesus</u> to the scribes declaration that he would "do whatever Jesus said to do", concerns:

the <u>missing 7th day Sabbath Rest</u> of <u>Jesus</u> and the <u>spiritual "rest"</u> that the <u>false prophets(foxes)</u> and <u>men(birds)</u> have <u>made for themselves</u>.

Just as real foxes make real holes, so false prophets (foxes) have removed part of Gods Word (holes), and as real birds make real nests, so men (birds) have put together spiritual materials (nests), to make for themselves a spiritual "rest day". Thus, Jesus was challenging the scribe who had declared that he 'would do whatever He said" to see if he would really obey His Words (to keep the 7th day Sabbath Rest) or whether he would obey the words of men (to keep another "rest" day).

Jesus is also challenging us to see if we will obey Him!

What is the "job" of a "shepherd"?

PSALMS 23

THE LORD is my **shepherd**; I shall not want.

2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures : he **leadeth** <u>me</u> beside the still waters.

THE "JOB" OF A SPIRITUAL **SHEPHERD** IS TO **LEAD** THE PEOPLE (SHEEP) IN THE <u>RIGHT WAY</u> OR THE <u>PATH OF **TRUTH**</u>.

How does a "shepherd" lead sheep?

JOHN 10: 2 But he that entereth in by the door is the **shepherd** of the <u>sheep</u>. **3** To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear <u>his</u> **voice**; and he calleth his own sheep by name, and **leadeth them** out. **4** And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the *sheep follow him*: for they know <u>his</u> **voice**.

A shepherd **leads** his sheep with **his voice**. Just as a sheep follows the voice of the shepherd, Similarly, **people** follow the **voice** of their **Minister**. They <u>do</u> what **he tells them** to do.

What have the **shepherds** done to the *sheep*?

JEREMIAH 50: 6 My **people** hath been lost sheep: their **shepherds** have *caused* them to <u>go astray</u>, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have <u>gone from mountain</u> to *hill*,....

The "shepherds" or **Ministers** have:

Caused the people to "go astray" or to leave the "right way" or the truth and to follow false teachings instead of the truth.

Caused the people to go from a "high place" (mountain) to a "lower place" (hill).

The people have gone from <u>following</u> **God's Word** (high place) to <u>following</u> **man's word**(lower place). They do what their Minister says to do instead of what God says to do.

What have the "sheep" forgotten?

JEREMIAH 50

6 My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have <u>forgotten</u> their **restingplace.**

The "sheep" have <u>forgotten</u> their "**restingplace**".

A "restingplace" is something that would provide <u>Physical</u> <u>Rest</u> for Physical sheep and something that would provide <u>Spiritual Rest</u> for Spiritual "sheep" or people.

Let's see what the Bible says about **Spiritual Rest**.

HEBREWS 4:3 Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left *us* of <u>entering into</u> **his rest**, any of you should seem to come short of it.

- **4** For he spake in a certain place of the <u>seventh day</u> on this wise, and <u>God did</u> **rest** the **seventh day** from all his works.
- **5** And in this place again, if they shall <u>enter into</u> **my rest**.
- **9** There *remainth* therefore a **rest** to the people of God. **10** For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his.
- 11 Let us labour therefore to <u>enter into</u> that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

Thus, the Bible says that the **restingplace** of God is **His 7**th **day Sabbath** and He invites **us** to enter into **His Rest** with Him. Clearly, the "restingplace" of the "sheep" or God's people is to be with Him in the Sabbath Rest.

The Bible verse we have been studying said that the "sheep" or people had **forgotten** their "restingplace".

In other words this Bible Parable is predicting that the 7th day Sabbath Rest of God's people would be "forgotten" by them!!! Let's see if this has happened.

The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20: 3-17)

Clearly the "shepherds" or Ministers have rejected the 7th day Sabbath Rest and as a result the "sheep" or God's people have forgotten their "restingplace".

We have seen that the Bible's prediction has come true, now let's see if we can discover **what caused** the "sheep" or God's people to **forget** the 7th day Sabbath Rest.

We know from our previous study that it was the "**shepherds**" that caused the "sheep" to go astray and therefore to forget their restingplace. So, we would expect that sometime in the past the "Church" made this change. Lets see if we are right.

"The **Sunday**, as a day of the week set apart for the obligatory public worship of Almighty God; to be sanctified by a suspension of all servile labor, trade, and worldly avocations and by exercises of devotion, is **purely** a **creation** of the **Catholic Church**.

The day and the regulations have <u>no logical basis</u> except the <u>authority of the Catholic Church</u>.

<u>In the primitive days</u> of fervor and piety all days were so consecrated by exercises of devotion that <u>no special command for the sanctification of the first day is traced</u>.

This became gradually obligatory, although the command was not at first peremptory. The Council of Laodicea, in 364 A.D., defines: "That Christians must not Judaize and refrain from manual labor on Saturday, but work on that day; and that, preferring the Lord's day, they must then rest, if this can be done, as becomes Christians".

The Church thus began by calling her children to sanctify the first day of the week, that on which God the Son rose from the dead, that, on which God the Father began the creation of the world, and God the Holy Ghost descended on the Apostles. Constantine lent the power of the state to enforce the regulations of the Church, and the civil law began to enforce the spiritual decrees. He commanded the Lord's day to be observed by all as a festival and day of rest.

Protestantism, in discarding the authority of the Church, **has** *no_good reason* for its <u>Sunday theory</u>, and ought, logically, to **keep <u>Saturday</u>** as the Sabbath, with the Jews and Seventh-Day Baptists."

Thus, the **Catholic Church** is clearly *responsible* for accomplishing the <u>change</u> of the days of <u>worship</u>!

Men and women did **not** willingly change from the 7^{th} day to the 1^{st} day.

They were <u>forced by civil laws</u> of the government, enforcing the decrees of the Catholic Church, to *make the change* or suffer the <u>penalty of the law</u>!

According to the Catholic Church, "<u>nothing in</u> <u>Scripture</u> requires the change or justifies it".

Most of the <u>Protestant world</u> has *accepted* the **change** of worship days from the **7**th to the **1**st day *without* having a **Biblical** basis for the change.

Now we are ready for a **final Paraphrase** of our Bible text.

THE LOST SHEEP

THAT HAVE FORGOTTEN

THEIR RESTINGPLACE

JEREMIAH 50

6 My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

PARAPHRASE:

My people are **lost people** (sheep)! Their **Pastors** and **Ministers** (Shepherds) have **caused** them to <u>leave the **truth**</u> and accept their <u>**false**</u> **teachings** (go astray).

They have **misled them** (turned them away) in the **churches**.

"remember" instead the 1st day SUNDAY!

They have convinced the people to accept **their words** (hill) instead of **God's Word** (mountain).

They have told them to **forget** the **7**th **day** <u>Sabbath</u> (forgotten "<u>restingplace</u>") of the LORD and to

The Parable of:

"The Lost Piece of Silver"

LUKE 15

8 Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find *it* ? **9** And when she hath found *it*, she calleth *her* friends and *her* neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.

Comments:

In this parable a <u>Physical woman</u> has **lost** something of great <u>Physical value</u> to her. She spares nothing in order to recover what she has lost. This parable will then be about a <u>Spiritual woman</u> (church) that has **lost** something of great <u>Spiritual value</u> and must spare no effort until she has recovered what she has lost.

Lets take a moment and think about this parable.

Since the <u>solution</u> to the problem is to to use *Physical light* (candle) to search for the lost item, then the parable will be about using *Spiritual light* to find the missing item.

Since the <u>solution</u> to the problem also requires removing *Physical dust* (sweeping), then the parable will be about removing *Spiritual dust* in order to see the missing item.

Since the <u>missing item</u> is a piece of *Physical silver*, then the parable will be about recovering a piece of *Spiritual silver* that has been lost.

Since the piece of Physical silver was lost in the *Physical house*, then the parable will be about a piece of Spiritual silver that has been lost in the *Spiritual house* or Church.

Jesus always reveals **valuable truth** to us in His Parables, but once again it is <u>hidden</u> and can only be understood as we discover the Spiritual meanings of the *Real Objects* used in the parable.

Now that we know the Spiritual meanings of the Real Objects in the parable, we are ready to substitute those meanings back into the parable so that we can understand the Spiritual meaning of the parable.

We now know that the parable is really about the Church (woman) using the Bible(light) to discover part of God's Words(silver) that she has lost.

In order to discover the missing Words of God the Church must remove(sweep) the words of men(dust) that have been hiding part of God's Words(silver).

The parable also told us that it is the Church(house) itself that is responsible for losing part of God's Words(silver) because of its lack of understanding (darkness).

What we yet need to discover is **what** Words of God are missing? Since "silver" is the object that Jesus used to represent God's missing Words, we need to once again look at the Spiritual meaning of "silver".

Psalms 119:72 "The **law** of thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and **silver.**

This Bible verse tells us that God's **Law(10 Com.)** is like **silver**. Now we know why there were **10 pieces** of **silver** in the parable! 10pieces=10Commandments.

The parable told us that **one** of the <u>pieces of silver</u> was **lost.** Thus, the parable is telling us that **one** of the <u>Commandments</u> of God would be **lost!** Now we need only to examine the 10 Com. to see *which* is **missing**.

The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20: 3-17)

- (1) 3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me
- (2) 4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
 - 5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them or serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God...
- (3) 7 Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy 3 ✓ ALL MINISTERS ACCEPT God in vain for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- (4) 8 Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy 9 Six days shalt thou labor and do all thy work
 - 10 But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work. Thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, that is within thy gates.
 - 11 For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- (5) 12 Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- (6) 13 Thou shalt not kill
- (7) 14 Thou shalt not commit adultery
- (8) 15 Thou shalt not steal
- (9) 16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor
- (10) 17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbor's

It is clear as we examine the 10 Commandments that the **one Law** or one Commandment that has been "**Lost**" is the **4**th **Commandment** which specifies which day that God says we are to worship him on.

Men's words(dust) have hidden God's Words(silver) and the Church has replaced the command of God to keep the 7th day(Saturday) holy with a command of men to

keep the 1st day(Sunday) holy.

History tells us exactly <u>how</u> and <u>when</u> this change was made by the Church.

"The **Sunday**, as a <u>day of the week set apart</u> for the obligatory_public **worship** of Almighty God; to be sanctified by a suspension of all servile labor, trade, and worldly avocations and by exercises of devotion, is **purely** a **creation** of the **Catholic Church**."

<u>"The Council of Laodicea, in 364 A.D., defines</u>: "That *Christians must not Judaize and refrain from manual labor on Saturday, but work on that day*; and that, <u>preferring the Lord's day, they must then rest</u>, if this can be done, as becomes Christians".

"The Church thus began by calling her children to sanctify the first day of the week, that on which God the Son rose from the dead, that, on which God the Father began the creation of the world, and God the Holy Ghost descended on the Apostles. Constantine lent the power of the state to enforce the regulations of the Church, and the civil law began to enforce the spiritual decrees. He commanded the Lord's day to be observed by all as a festival and day of rest."

Thus, we see from this historical document exactly <u>how</u> the change of worship days was made. Once the change was made, the churches have continued to promote the keeping of Sunday because it has become a "tradition of men" even though it cannot be solidly defended from the Bible.

The question now is "Can we still honor God by worshiping Him on another day than the day that He has specified that we should worship Him on?

Let's take one last look at the 10 Commandments and see if we can answer this question.

The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20 : 3-17)

(1) "Thou shalt have no other gods before me."

This commandment is very plain. We are <u>not</u> to <u>commit idolatry</u> by worshipping another god.

(2) "Thou shalt *not make* unto thee any **graven** image, or **any likeness** of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth..."

This commandment is not as plain. Lets see what the Bible means by "graven image" by looking in the Concordance for other Bible texts using this word.

Exodus 32: 15,16 "And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the *two tables of testimony* were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides: on the one side and on the other side were they written. And the <u>tables were the work of God</u>, and the writing was the <u>writing of God</u>, **graven** upon the tables."

The 2nd Commandment told us:

(2) "Thou shalt *not make* unto thee any **graven** image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath,.."

An "**image**" is something <u>made in the likeness</u> of something else. The 4th Com. "**graven**" on tables of stone by God, specifies worship on the **7**th **day**(Saturday). The Church has made an "**image**" or "<u>likeness</u>" of God's Com. by specifying worship on the **1**st **day**(Sunday) and enforced its "commandment" by Civil law.

By worshipping on **any** other day than what God has specified in the 4th Commandment, the Church *causes* people to commit IDOLATRY because they are worshipping an "**image**" of God's Commandment which has been "**graven**" by man!!

Clearly, we have the answer to our question of; "Can we still honor God by worshiping Him on another day than the day that He has specified that we should worship Him on?

Jesus addressed the <u>Church leaders</u> of His day with a question. "Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition? For God commanded, saying,
Honour thy father and mother...But ye say, "Whosoever shall say..honour not his father and mother, he shall be free." Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition. ...But <u>in vain</u> they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men." Matthew 15:3-9

Now we see why Jesus has repeatedly warned us in his parables to <u>base all our beliefs</u> on **God's Words** instead of **men's words**. The last *blessing* of Jesus in the Bible is found in the last chapter of the Bible as He blesses commandment keepers. Rev. 22: 14-16 "**Blessed** are they that <u>do his commandments</u>, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. For without are dogs, and sorcerors, and whoremongers, and murderers, and <u>idolaters</u> and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie. **I Jesus** have sent my angel to <u>testify unto you these things</u> in the churches.."

Now it is time for our **final Paraphrase** of the Parable.

The **Parable** of: The <u>Lost Piece</u> of Silver LUKE 15

8 Either what woman having **ten pieces** of **silver**, if she <u>lose</u> **one piece**, doth not **light a candle**, and **sweep** the **house**, and seek diligently till she find *it*? 9 And when she hath found *it*, she calleth *her* friends and *her* neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have <u>found the piece</u> which I had lost.

Paraphrase:

What Church(woman) having the **10 Com**.(10 pc/silver), if the Church(she) <u>loses</u> **1 Com**.(1 pc), <u>does not study the Bible</u>(light a candle) and remove the teachings of men(sweep away dust) from the Church(house) and seek diligently until the Church(she) **finds** the **lost Com**.(it)?

And when the Church(she) has found the lost Com.(it), the Church(she) calls her friends and her neighbors together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have **found** the **4**th **Commandment** which I had lost.

Summary:

We have seen how <u>Jesus</u> in the Parable of "The Lost Piece of Silver" has **warned us** that the "Church" would **lose** <u>one of the Commandments</u> and history has verified that it happened just as Jesus said it would.

The "Good News" is that in the <u>same Parable</u>, Jesus has also told us that the "woman" would **find** the **lost pc** of silver!! Thus Jesus has told us that **His People** would re-discover the **4**th **Commandment** and in turn would re-discover the **7**th **day Sabbath Truth**!!

PARAPHRASE:

"The Spring of Water healed by Salt"

The **leaders** of God's people were **not obeying** GOD'S **LAW** of 10 Commandments.

They were setting a **bad example** for the <u>rest of God's people</u>, who then <u>followed</u> their <u>leaders</u> **example!**

The **result** of this was that the <u>unconverted people</u> around them were **remaining unconverted**!!

Instead of being led to give their heart to the Lord by observing the lives of God's people, as they obeyed God's Law and represented Him in Character, instead, they could see no difference between the way they were living and the way Gods' people were living!

When the **leadership** of God's people began to <u>keep God's Law</u> and to be **guided by Him**, then God's <u>people</u> began to **follow** their <u>leaders example</u> and to **also** keep <u>God's Law</u>.

As the **unconverted people** around them began to observe how God's <u>people</u> were "**loving their neighbors as themselves**", they began to notice the <u>difference</u> and began to ask questions. In a short time the Holy Spirit had <u>given them</u> "new hearts" and they too began to <u>keep God's Law</u> and to "<u>love</u> their **neighbors** as **themselves**".

- There will be no peace as long as the <u>False church</u> continues to join herself in union(whoredom) with the <u>Civil powers</u> and continues to teach things which God's word forbids.
- Jezebel painted her face and put up her hair and tried to make herself look attractive.
- The <u>False church</u> makes herself look very attractive on the outside.
- The prophecy of the Lord given by Elijah came true. The dogs did eat Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel and only her skull, feet, and hands were left.
- 2. The prophecy of the Lord concerning the False church will come true. She will be completely exposed. Her evil thoughts (skull), her evil actions (feet&hands) will be revealed by God's Law (portion of Jezreel) to the Gentiles (dogs) and they will destroy her.
- The carcase of Jezebel was as dung on the ground so that she could not be identified.
- The <u>False church</u> will be completly destroyed so that nothing will be left to identify her by.
- Jesus does not want the church to allow Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess to teach and and to seduce his people.
- Jesus does not want the church to allow the <u>False church</u> to seduce and deceive people with her teachings.

The Story that the Bible tells us about the "Word" JEZEBEL.

Literal Story:

Jezebel, the daughter of a heathen king, married the king of Israel, Ahab, and Ahab began to serve Baal (sun god) and to worship him. Jezebel persecuted and killed the prophets of the Lord. Elijah then slew the prophets of Baal with the sword. Jezebel then threatened Elijah with death. Ahab was sad and would not eat bread and Jezebel wanted to know why. Naboth would not give the king his vineyard but Jezebel promised the king that she would give him the vineyard of Naboth. She sent letters to all the elders and nobles telling them to "set Naboth on high" and to then hire false witnesses against him. They did as she asked and then Naboth was stoned to death. Jezebel then told the king to take possesion of Naboth's vineyard. The Lord said that "the dogs would eat Jezebel by the wall of Jezreel". There was no king more wicked than Ahab whom Jezebel had stirred up. Because of Jezebel the house of Ahab would be smitten with judgments by the Lord. There would be no peace as long as Jezebel contuined to practice her whoredom and witchcraft. Jezebel painted her face and tried to make herself look attractive but it was to no avail because the prophecy of the Lord came true. The dogs ate Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel and only her skull, feet, and hands were left. She could not even be identified. Jesus does not want Jezebel to teach and seduce his people to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols.

The **Story** that the Bible tells us about the "Word" **JEZEBEL**.

Spiritual Story:

The False church(impure woman) makes a union (marriage) with the Civil power(king). The Civil power begins to promote the worship of the sun. The False church begins to persecute the leaders (prophets) of Gods people and to spiritually"cut them off". The leaders of Gods people fight back with the spiritual sword(Bible) and spiritually defeat the leaders of the False church. INTRODUCTION:

THE WALL

One of the most fascinating "words" to study in the Bible is the word "wall". This word "wall" is used interchangeably with the word "hedge" in the Bible.

A "wall" or a "hedge" is used by God to show His Protective Care for His people as the "wall" or "hedge" surrounds them. When the "wall" or "hedge" is broken down or removed, the enemy takes God's people captive!

The entire "wall" does not have to be broken down or removed for the enemy to get to God's people.

Only a "gap" or "breach" has to be made in the "wall" and then the enemy can attack God's people.

If the enemy can convince God's people that the "wall" is not very important, and can prevent them from keeping the "wall" in good repair, then he will eventually **defeat them**!

With this background let us now begin our study of The "Wall".

...O Wall of the Daughter of Zion... The "Wall" is the APPLE let not the **apple** of thine eye cease.



Let's see what the <u>physical meaning</u> of the word "**Breach**" means by using the Concordance :

BREACH... be to you as a b ready to fall...... Isa 30:13 # 6556 # 6556 perets, peh-rets; from # 6555; a break (lit.or fig.) **breach**, breaking forth (in), x forth, **gap**.

Thus, a "Breach" is a break or gap or hole,

We previously learned that there is a "Breach" in the "Wall".

Since a "breach" is a gap or hole, and the "wall" represents God's Law, then a "breach" in the "wall" represents a "hole" in the "Law" or "one commandment missing" from God's "Law".

Now, lets discover the spiritual meaning of "breach"

1 Chronicles 13: 10 And the anger of the Lord was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God. 11 And David was displeased, because the Lord had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Pē'-rēz-uzza to this day.





When a "hole" was made In the "wall" or when "one commandment" was removed from the "Law" God revealed to Ezekiel that men would then be worshipping the sun.

The <u>implication</u> is that the part of <u>God's Law</u> that is "**missing**" is the **4**th **Commandment** that tells us to **keep** the **7**th **day Sabbath** holy.

The Sunday, as a day of the week set apart for the obligatory public worship of Almighty God; to be sanctified by a suspension of all servile labor, trade, and worldly avocations and by exercises of devotion, is purely a creation of the Catholic Church.

In the primitive days of fervor and piety all days were so consecrated by exercises of devotion that no special command for the sanctification of the first day is traced.

This became gradually obligatory, although the command was not at first peremptory. The Council of Laodicea, in 364 A.D. defines: "That Christians must not Judaize and refrain from manual labor on Saturday, but work on that day; and that, preferring the Lord's day, they must then rest, if this can be done, as becomes Christians".

The Church thus began by calling her children to sanctify the first day of the week,

Constantine lent the power of the state to enforce the regulations of the Church, and the civil law began to enforce the spiritual decrees. He commanded the Lord's day to be observed by all as a festival and day of rest.

<u>Protestantism</u>, in discarding the authority of the Church, <u>has no good reason</u> for its <u>Sunday theory</u>, and ought, logically, to <u>keep Saturday</u> as the <u>Sabbath</u>, with the Jews and Seventh-Day Baptists.

THE **CATHOLIC CHURCH** IS THE "one"who caused the "removal" of **God's commandment**.

What **commandment** of **God** has been "**removed**" from the **10 commandment LAW** thereby causing a "**breach**" or "**hole**" in the **LAW**.



Thanks for your continued and excellent work in your Bible Correspondence Courses. This letter is in response to your observation about the ten commandments. The following is sent for your consideration with hope it will be helpful.

The ten commandments are a part of the law of Moses which was God's law for the nation of Israel in the Old Testament days. We find the ten commandments listed both in Exodus chapter 20 and in Deuteronomy chapter 5. A close reading of these passages will show that this law was between God and Israel. This is the law which Christ fulfilled (Matthew 5: 17). He took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross (Colossians 2: 14-17).

It is often said that Jesus took only the ceremonial law away but left the **moral** part of the law. Of course, the Bible teaches just the contrary. He took **all** of the **law out of the way** and <u>we are no longer under the law of Moses</u>. In Romans chapter seven, Paul is discussing the fact that under Christ, we "become dead to the law by the body Christ" (Romans 7 : 3). In verse six he says "we are delivered from the law". In verse seven he is very specific and identifies the law by one of its precepts namely "Thou shalt not covet". Obviously, the ten commandments, of which "Thou shalt not covet" is one, are a part of that which we have been delivered from.

Well, does this mean that we can have other gods, or build idols, or take God's name in vain, etc. Of course not. But the reason why is because the law of Christ, under which all people now live... forbids these things. In fact, some of the ten commandments are listed in Paul's letter to the Romans (Romans 13:9). This makes them a part of the law of Christ. Some of the ten commandments have been made even stronger. For example, under the ten commandments, murder was condemned; under the law of Christ, becoming angry which leads to murder is condemned (Matthew 5: 21-22). Under the law of Christ adultery may be committed even in the heart (Matthew 5: 27-28).

The **one law** of the ten commandments which is **not** part of the **law** of Christ is the **Sabbath** observance. Even those today who claim we ought to keep the Old Testament ten commandments do not keep the seventh day; and those who do profess to keep the seventh day do not do so as the Old Testament teaches; they have made new rules, which, of course, God prohibits.

I hope this will be of some assistance. I realize it sounds strange to many to say, we are not to keep the ten commandments today. However, once we see the true Bible teaching on the subject, we realize that we live under even a better law. The great principles which were so important to the nation of Israel have been made even greater for us under the law of Christ.







The "repairer" of the "breach" is one who keeps the <u>Sabbath</u> Holy!

Someone "**keeping**" the <u>7th day Sabbath</u> of the **4th commandment** or advising **others** to **keep it** is called a "*repairer*" of the **breach** by God.

God has told us that He will have men who will replace what is "missing" from His "WALL" or "LAW".

MATTHEW 5

- **17** Think <u>not</u> that I am come to <u>destroy</u> the <u>law</u>, or the prophets : I am **not come** to **destroy**, but to fulfil.
- **18** For verily I say unto you, till <u>heaven</u> and <u>earth pass</u> <u>one jot or one title</u> shall in no wise <u>pass from the law</u>, till all be fullfilled.
- 19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

PARAPHRASE

Ezekiel 13: 10 The reason is because they have seduced my people, giving a message of peace when there was no peace. Also, one of the false teachers is responsible for taking My Words that I wrote on Stone, My Ten Commandments (wall), and changed them by telling my people that I said something that I didn't say (built up a wall). Then, other false teachers have assisted him by hiding this change from the people in a "coverup" or "whitewash" of the facts (daubed with untempered mortar).

Ezekiel 13: 11-13 Tell those men that have changed My Words into their words (daubed with untempered mortar) that "their commandments" (daubed wall) will not stand forever but will fall. I will cause the Holy Spirit (overflowing shower) to be poured out on the people and they will see that My Law on tables of stone (great hailstones) is different than your law and among the people there will be a great controversy over doctrine (stormy wind). This will cause the people to see the truth and your commandments, the "commandments of men" (wall daubed with untempered mortar) will no longer fool them (wall will fall).

Ezekiel 13: 14-15 Yes, I will break down your "wall" of commandments that men have established, and when I do, everyone will be able to see that it has for its foundation only the words of men instead of the Words of God. Then, you false prophets and false teachers will be consumed in the midst and you shall know that I am the LORD.



CONCLUSION

The "tower" represents the Lord. His "watchmen" or <u>ministers</u> or <u>priests</u> are to "stand on Him" as their <u>strength</u>, <u>rock</u> and <u>salvation</u>!

The **Lord**, their "tower" would allow them to "see" the enemy and to then warn the people.

The "tower" allowed a "watchman" to see things he could not normally see.

STONY GROUND

Mark 4:5 And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth. 6 But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.

Ezk 11: 19 And I will give them <u>one heart</u>, and I will <u>put</u> a **new spirit** within you; and I will take the **stony** heart out of their flesh, and give them an <u>heart of flesh</u>. **20** That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them...

CONCLUSION

The "stony" ground represents a hard heart, which is **not willing** to obey God.

The "spirit" in that heart is not God's Spirit.

GOOD GROUND

Luke 8:8 And **other** fell on **good** ground, and sprang up, and <u>bare</u> **fruit** an hundred fold. And when he had said these things, he cried, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Throughout this parable <u>in each case</u> the "<u>seed</u>" fell <u>upon</u> "**something**" that represented the **condition of a person's heart**. Example: **stony** <u>ground</u>.

Job 42:24 His **heart** is as firm as a **stone**; yea as **hard** as a piece of nether millstone.

Stony ground = (hard) heart

Thus, **good** ground would again represent the **condition** of a person's heart.

Good ground = (soft) heart

Ezk 36: 26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh and give you an heart of flesh. (soft heart)




The <u>seed</u> only produced <u>fruit</u> when it fell upon <u>good ground</u>
Thus the <u>Word</u> (seed) only produces the <u>Christian Virtues</u> (fruit) when it falls upon a "soft" converted heart (good ground).

CONCLUSION

When the "stones" were gathered out of the vineyard, that represented the Lord removing those with hard "stony" hearts from among His people. Only the Lord can look on the heart to see if it is "hard" (stony) or unconverted or whether it is "soft" (good ground) or converted!









Since the "vineyard" represents <u>Israel</u> or "<u>the Church</u>", we would expert that the "**grapes**" or <u>fruit</u> of the vineyard has something to do with the **people**.

Comparing Scriptures:





Hosea 9:10 I found **Israel** like **grapes** in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the first ripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to $B\bar{a}$ - \bar{a} l- $p\bar{e}$ - \hat{o} r, and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they loved.



FRUIT = Righteousness and Souls Won

Phil. 1:11 "..the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ.

Prov. 11:30 "The fruit of righteousness is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise."

Galatians 5: 22 But the fruit of Spirit is: love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,...

Ephesians 5:9 For the **fruit** of **spirit** in all **goodness** and righteousness and **truth**. Thus, "**grapes**" represent the **people** and what they are **like**. "**Good grapes**" having the "**fruit**" of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> or "**Wild**" **grapes** having the <u>character</u> of **Satan**.

Deuteronomy 32: For their vine is of the vine of **Sodom**, and of the fields of Gō-mŏr-rǎh: their **grapes** are grapes of gall, their clusters are bitter: **33** Their wine is the poison of dragon, and the cruel venom of asps.

Jeremiah 8:13 I will surely <u>consume them</u>, saith the Lord: *there shall be* **no grapes** on the vine, nor figs on the fig tree, and the leaf shall fade; and *the things that* I have given them shall <u>pass away from them</u>.






Jeremiah 48:33 And joy and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab; and I have caused **wine** to <u>fail from the</u>


winepress: none shall tread with shouting; their shouting shall be no shouting.

"Wine" comes from the winepress. "New wine" is true doctrine. If the "wine" is not coming from the winepress, then truth is not being taught.









Thus, one meaning of "to tread the winepress" is to teach doctrine to someone.

Isaiah 63: 2 Wherefore *art thou* red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that <u>treadeth in the</u> **winevat** ? **3** I have <u>trodden the</u> **winepress** alone; and of the people *there was* none with me: for <u>I will tread</u> **them** <u>in mine</u> <u>anger</u>, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. **4** For <u>the day of vengeance</u> *is* in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come. **5** And I looked, and <u>there was</u> none to help; and I wondered that *there was* none to uphold:

therefore mine own arm brought salvation unto me; and my fury, it up held me. **6** And <u>I will tread down the people in mine</u> **anger**, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

The "grapes" or "people" will be trodden in the "winepress" by God in His anger and vengeance!

Lamentations 2:15 The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty *men* in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, *as* in a winepress. 16 For these *things* I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed. 17 Zion spreadeth forth her hands, *and there is* none to comfort her: the Lord hath commanded concerning Jacob, *that* his adversaries *should be* round about him: **Jerusalem** is a **menstruous woman** among them.

The people of the Lord have sinned against Him.





The <u>second meaning</u> of "to **tread** the **winepress**" represents the **judgment** and **wrath** of God poured out upon the **wicked**.

The "thorns" and "briers" represent wicked people and the pleasures of this world.

When **wicked people** are allowed to <u>remain</u> in the church, **they** <u>influence</u> <u>other people</u> to **do wrong**.


When God's people allow the **pleasures** of <u>this world</u> to take up <u>so much</u> <u>of their</u> **time** that they do **not** <u>have **time**</u> to **study Gods' Word**, they are being **choked** by "**thorns**"!!


Even good things can take up too much time!

10 What does the "rain" represent?

The "rain" represents the Holy Spirit.

The command to "withhold the rain" signifies the removal of the Holy Spirit from the people.





Jeremiah 3:3 Therefore the **showers** have been **withholden**, and there hath been **no latter rain**; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

ISAIAH 5: Now will I sing to my well beloved a song of my beloved touching his vineyard. My well beloved hath a **vineyard** in a very fruitful

hill: 2 And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes. 3 And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem, and men of Judah, judge, I pray you, betwixt me and my vineyard. 4 What could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it? wherefore, when I looked that it should bring forth grapes, brought it forth wild grapes? 5 And now go to; I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard: I will take away the hedge thereof, and it shall be eaten up; and break down the wall thereof, and it shall be trodden down: 6 And I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor digged; but there shall come up briers and thorns: I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it. 7 For the vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgement, but behold oppressions; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

4. Substitute the Spiritual Meaning for the Real Objects

PARAPHRASE

I will tell you the story of **Jesus** (beloved) and <u>His people Israel</u> (vineyard). Jesus <u>protected</u> Israel (fenced vineyard). He <u>removed the</u> **unconverted** (gathered out stones), from their midst and left only those who were converted (choicest vine).

He offered his <u>strength</u> and <u>salvation</u> (tower) to them and expected that the <u>leaders</u> and <u>teachers</u> would <u>watch</u> and <u>warn</u> the people (tower).

He told them of the <u>judgement</u> to come (winepress). When the time of <u>harvest</u> came, he expected <u>his people</u> (grapes) to have the **fruits** of **the Spirit** (grapes) and to have won <u>many converts</u> (grapes).

Instead, they had become disobedient and wicked (wild grapes).

After doing all that he could for them, he finally <u>removed his blessings</u> (take away hedge) because <u>His law</u> (wall) that had protected them, was <u>no longer kept</u> (wall broken down).

He no longer <u>removed</u> wicked people (thorns not removed) from their midst and the people, following their bad example, spent their time on the pleasures of the world (thorns not removed), instead of working for the Lord.

Finally, the Lord <u>removed His Holy Spirit</u> from them (command no rain to fall), and said that **Israel** would be **under the power of** others (vineyard trodden down).
