

What does "Midnight" or "darkness" REPRESENT?




DARKNESS = LACK OF UNDERSTANDING (ERROR)

Ps. 82:5 "They know not, neither do they understand, they walk on in darkness..."

MIDNIGHT (Greatest Physical Darkness)
(Greatest Spiritual Darkness) or ERROR

"Midnight" REPRESENTS "Lack of understanding" AT THE END of TIME



(Bread in 3 parts)


THREE ANGELS MESSAGE

(see Matt 13:33 study)

Matt 4:4 "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

"Three loaves of bread" represent "God's Word in three parts"

DOOR = Jesus (I know you not)

(shut) (PROBATION CLOSED)

John 10:9 "Lam the door: By me if any man enter in, he shall be saved..."





Who does "My Children" represent?




CHILDREN (My) = GOD'S PEOPLE

"My Children" represent "God's People"

What does it mean to "Eat" or "Be Fed"?



EAT = Read (to gain knowledge) to "feed" = to "teach"

JERE 15:16 'Thy words were found and I did eat them: and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart." ACTS 2:46 "... and breaking bread from house to house, did eat.."

To "Eat" means to "Gain Spiritual Knowledge"

HUNGER

(SPIRITUAL) "HUNGER" is : to be without a knowledge of GOD'S WORD

HUNGER (FOR 3 LOAVES OF BREAD) (SPIRITUAL) "HUNGER" for the 3 MESSAGES of the 3 ANGELS in GOD'S WORD

THE FRIEND AT MIDNIGHT

LUKE 11:5-8

5 And he said unto them, which of you shall have a <u>friend</u>, and shall go unto <u>him</u> at <u>midnight</u>, and say unto him, <u>Friend</u>, lend me three loaves;

6 For a <u>friend</u> of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have <u>nothing to set before him</u>?

PARAPHRASE 1

During the time of **Greatest Spiritual Error** (midnight), people who have **nothing to satisfy their spiritual hunger** or their friends spiritual hunger (nothing to set before him) will plead with the **Lord** (Friend) for the **truth from His Word**, which is **in three parts** (three loaves of bread). **God's people** (children) who are <u>with Him</u> in the **Sabbath Rest and Relationship** (with him in bed), have had <u>their</u> **probation close** (door shut). Yet, because of the reverence of those **outside** (importunity # 335, # 247, # 127) who hunger after the truth, the Lord will <u>satisfy their hunger</u> with the truth of the **Three Angels Message** (three loaves of bread) before their probation closes (he will rise and give him).

PARAPHRASE 2

Which of you shall have someone you trust (friend) and shall **END** him at the of Time when Error Greatest (MIDNIGHT) and say to him Lord (friend) give me the **3 Messages** of the 3 Angels from your Word (3 loaves). A friend of mine has come to visit me and I have **nothing to** satisfy his Spiritual Hunger (nothing to set before him). And the **Lord** shall answer and say **Probation** has **closed** on my people (door shut) who are with me in the Sabbath REST and **RELATIONSHIP** (with me in bed). I can't rise and give you. Even though he is not his friend, yet because of his need and his reverence and persistance (importunity) he will rise and give him the <u>3 ANGELS MESSAGES</u> before his probation closes.

"The Friend at Midnight who asks for three loaves of bread"

Review of Luke 11:5-8

This Parable teaches the following

- 1 God <u>Identifies</u> His Church with a Unique Message: The **3 Angels Message**.
- 2 The <u>Three Angels Message</u> will satisfy the <u>Spiritual hunger</u> of people.
- 3 Probation closes on God's Church first.
- 4 God's Church will be "**resting**" with **Him** (keeping the Sabbath) while those outside the church are **not** "resting" with **Him**.
- 5 The Three Angels Message will go to everyone before probation closes for the world.

THE LAST DAY MESSAGE TO ALL THE WORLD

(3 ANGELS MESSAGE)

FIRST ANGEL'S MESSAGE

REV 14:6 "And I saw another **angel** fly in the midst of heaven, having the **everlasting gospel** to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

(EVERLASTING GOSPEL) Same means of Salvation for all:

REV 14:7 "Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and **give glory to him**; for the **hour of his judgement is come**; and **worship him that made heaven, and earth**, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

(GIVE GLORY TO GOD) Christian Living

(HOUR OF HIS JUDGEMENT IS COME) Judgement is NOW in session

(WORSHIP THE CREATOR) The Sabbath of the Lord honors Him as the Creator (Exodus 20:10)

SECOND ANGEL'S MESSAGE

REV 14:8 "And there followed <u>another</u> **angel**, saying, **Babylon is fallen**, **is fallen**, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

(BABYLON IS FALLEN) Warning against the religious confusion and doctrine of the Churches

THIRD ANGEL'S MESSAGE

REV 14:9 "And the <u>third angel</u> followed them, saying with a loud voice, **If any man worship the beast and his image**, and **receive his mark** in his forehead, or in his hand.

REV 14:10 "The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb.

(WARNING NOT TO WORSHIP THE BEAST

OR TO RECEIVE HIS MARK) Warning against a specific religious power not to worship as it does nor receive its mark.

Other Bible Study Helps:
