




LIGHT A CANDLE=Study the Bible to understand truth




### DARKNESS = LACK OF UNDERSTANDING (ERROR)

THE "HOUSE" represents THE "CHURCH"

### **ISAIAH 28**

17 Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummer: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

The Bible uses the word "<u>sweep</u>" in the context of <u>removing evil</u> or <u>removing something</u> that is **false** (lies).

If the <u>woman</u> had to "<u>sweep</u>" the <u>house</u> in order to find the piece of silver, then there **must** have been **dust** or **dirt** or **sand** which was **hiding** the <u>piece</u> of silver and had to be "**swept** <u>away</u>" before the <u>silver piece</u> could be **seen** 

Similarly the **church** (woman) must have had to **remove** (<u>sweep</u> away) the "**dust**" or "**sand**" of **man's words**, before **God's Words** (SILVER PIECE) could he **seen**!

(PHYSICAL) The <u>woman</u> has <u>lost</u> something of **value**(SPIRITUAL) The **church** has lost something of **spiritual value**

  - (PHYSICAL) The <u>woman</u> lost <u>1 piece</u> of <u>10 pieces</u> of silver

(PHYSICAL) The <u>woman</u> "lit a candle" to produce light in the <u>house</u> so she could **see** and then <u>swept the house</u> to <u>remove</u> the <u>dust</u> and

dirt that was hiding the 1 piece of silver.

(SPIRITUAL) The church began to "study the Bible" (GOD'S WORD) to see truth and the church began to understand and it began to remove the lies and the false teaching of man that was hiding the 1 Commandment of GOD that was LOST!

6 Did the woman find the 1 piece of silver easily?

(PHYSICAL) The <u>woman</u> had to **seek** and **search** diligently.

(SPIRITUAL) The church had to spiritually search the scriptures diligently, comparing them, to find the missing Commandment of God that was LOST.

7 What did the woman do after she found the 1 piece of silver that was missing?

(PHYSICAL) The <u>woman</u> **rejoiced** and called her <u>friends</u> and <u>neighbors</u> to **share** the **good news** of **finding** the <u>1 piece</u> of **silver** that

had been **lost**.

(SPIRITUAL)

The **church rejoiced** and began to **share** the "**Good News**" of **finding** the **1 Commandment** of **God** that had been **lost** by the **church**!

### COMMENTS:

- 1 The Church (woman) is responsible for 1 Commandment of God (1 piece of SILVER) being lost!
- 2 The <u>1 law</u> of God (1 piece of SILVER) was **lost in** the **church** (house).
- 3 The **church** (house) was full of **Error** and **False Teaching** (darkness).
- 4 In order to **find** the **LOST Commandment** (1 piece of SILVER), the **church** (woman) had to **Study the Bible** (light a candle).
- 5 The truth (light) of the Bible (candle) <u>removed</u> the <u>error</u> and false teaching (darkness) and helped the <u>church</u> (woman) to find the <u>LOST commandment</u> (lost piece of silver).
- 6 The **LOST commandment** (lost piece of SILVER) was **hidden** because of the **teaching of men** (silver piece covered with dust + dirt).
- 7 The church (woman) had to remove (sweep away) the words of men (dust + dirt) and then she could clearly see the LOST Words of God, and she found the missing Commandment (1 piece of silver).
- 8 The church (woman) searched diligently in order to find the LOST Commandment (LOST piece of silver) and when she had found it she shared the Good News with her friends and neighbors!

### The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20 : 3-17)

- (1) 3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me
- (2) 4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
  - 5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them or serve them : for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God...
- (3) 7 Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain for the Lord will not hold him quiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- (4) 8 Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy 9 Six days shalt thou labor and do all thy work

### POPULAR TEACHING (CHURCH OF CHRIST)

Dear Diane, May 31, 2000

Thanks for your continued and excellent work in your Bible Correspondence Courses. This letter is in response to your observation about the ten commandments. The following is sent for your consideration with hope it will be helpful.

The ten commandments are a part of the law of Moses which was God's law for the nation of Israel in the Old Testament days. We find the ten commandments listed both in Exodus chapter 20 and in Deuteronomy chapter 5. A close reading of these passages will show that this law was between God and Israel. This is the law which Christ fulfilled (Matthew 5: 17). He took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross (Colossians 2: 14-17).

It is often said that Jesus took only the ceremonial law away but left the moral part of the law. Of course, the Bible teaches just the contrary. He took all of the law out of the way and we are no longer under the law of Moses. In Romans chapter seven, Paul is discussing the fact that under Christ, we "become dead to the law by the body Christ" (Romans 7 : 3). In verse six he says "we are delivered from the law". In verse seven he is very specific and identifies the law by one of its precepts namely "Thou shalt not covet". Obviously, the ten commandments, of which "Thou shalt not covet" is one, are a part of that which we have been delivered from.

Well, does this mean that we can have other gods, or build idols, or take God's name in vain, etc. Of course not. But the reason why is because the law of Christ, under which all people now live... forbids these things. In fact, some of the ten commandments are listed in Paul's letter to the Romans (Romans 13:9). This makes them a part of the law of Christ. Some of the ten commandments have been made even stronger. For example, under the ten commandments, murder was condemned; under the law of Christ, becoming angry which leads to murder is condemned (Matthew 5: 21-22). Under the law of Christ adultery may be committed even in the heart (Matthew 5: 27-28).

The **one law** of the ten commandments which is **not** part of the **law** of Christ is the **Sabbath** observance. Even those today who claim we ought to keep the Old Testament ten commandments do not keep the seventh day; and those who do profess to keep the seventh day do not do so as the Old Testament teaches; they have made new rules, which, of course, God prohibits.

I hope this will be of some assistance. I realize it sounds strange to many to say, we are not to keep the ten commandments today. However, once we see the true Bible teaching on the subject, we realize that we live under even a better law. The great principles which were so important to the nation of Israel have been made even greater for us under the law of Christ.

# FROM JANUARY to OCTOBER, 1883 THE OBSERVANCE OF SUNDAY AND CIVIL LAWS FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT, 139

The **Sunday**, as a day of the week set apart for the obligatory public **worship** of Almighty God; to be sanctified by a suspension of all servile labor, trade, and worldly avocations and by exercises of devotion, is **purely** a **creation** of the **Catholic Church**.

The Sunday laws are in their origin a part of the Catholic system enforced by the state when Europe was Catholic. <u>The day and the regulations have no logical basis except the authority of the Catholic Church</u>.

<u>In the primitive days</u> of fervor and piety all days were so consecrated by exercises of devotion that <u>no special</u> command for the sanctification of the first day is traced.

This became gradually obligatory, although the command was not at first peremptory. The Council of Laodicea, in 364 A.D., defines: "That Christians must not Judaize and refrain from manual labor on Saturday, but work on that day; and that, preferring the Lord's day, they must then rest, if this can be done, as becomes Christians".

The Church thus began by calling her children to sanctify the first day of the week, that on which God the Son rose from the dead, that, on which God the Father began the creation of the world, and God the Holy Ghost descended on the Apostles. She commanded a laying aside of business, a refraining from servile work, as a means to the end she had in view, the sanctification of the day.

<u>Constantine</u> lent the <u>power of the state</u> to <u>enforce</u> the <u>regulations</u> of the <u>Church</u>, and the <u>civil law</u> began to <u>enforce</u> the <u>spiritual decrees</u>. <u>He commanded the Lord's day to be observed by all</u> as a festival and <u>day of rest</u>.

<u>Protestantism</u>, in discarding the authority of the Church, <u>has no good reason</u> for its <u>Sunday theory</u>, and ought, logically, to <u>keep Saturday</u> as the <u>Sabbath</u>, with the Jews and Seventh-Day Baptists.

### **COMMENTS**

Thus, the <u>Catholic Church</u> is clearly <u>responsible</u> for accomplishing the <u>change</u> of the days of <u>worship</u>!

Men and women did <u>not</u> <u>willingly change</u> from the <u>7<sup>th</sup> day</u> to <u>1<sup>st</sup> day</u>.

They were <u>forced by civil laws</u> of the government, enforcing the decrees of the <u>Catholic Church</u>, to <u>make the change</u> or suffer the <u>penalty of the law</u>!

According to the Catholic Church, "nothing in Scripture requires the change or justifies it".

Most of the <u>Protestant world</u> has <u>accepted</u> the <u>change</u> of <u>worship days</u> from the <u>7<sup>th</sup></u> to the <u>1<sup>st</sup> day</u> without having a <u>Biblical or Scriptural basis</u> for the change.

### FINAL CONCLUSIONS

You have just seen how <u>God predicted</u> in <u>His Word</u> that the <u>Church</u> would "<u>lose</u>" one of His Commandments.

You have also seen <u>how</u> the <u>Church</u> used the <u>Civil power</u> to <u>force</u> men to worship on the  $1^{st}$  day instead the  $7^{th}$  day.

You have also seen a <u>typical letter</u> from a "teacher" telling a student that of all the Commandments, only the <u>4<sup>th</sup> Commandment</u> (7<sup>th</sup> Day <u>Sabbath</u>) should <u>not</u> be kept.

Now **you** will have to <u>decide</u> whether you will accept <u>man's word</u> or whether you will accept <u>God's Word</u>!
