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Matthew 9: 18 - 25

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- 20 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the hem of his garment:
- 21 For she said within herself, if I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.
- 22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

23 And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise, 24 He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn. 25 But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

THE WOMAN WHITH THE ISSUE OF BLOOD


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- 1 Why does the Bible begin with one story about a dead daughter and in the middle of it tell another story about a woman with an issue of blood?

The <u>outer story</u> presents the <u>problem.</u> (Woman Dead - <u>Church</u> Dead)
The inner story presents the **solution**. (Woman Healed - Church Healed)

2 What does a "woman" represent Spiritually ?



WOMAN= God's church

(Pure) (True Church)

ISA 54:5.6 "Thy Maker is thy husband, the Lord of Hosts is His name... the Lord hath called thee, as a woman... and a wife..."

REV 19:7.8 "... the marriage of the Lamb is come and His wife... arrayed

in fine linen, clean and white. ."

THE "WOMAN" REPRESENTS THE "CHURCH"

LEVITICUS 15

19 And if a woman have an issue, and her issue in her flesh be blood, she shall be put apart seven days: and whosoever toucheth her shall be unclean until the even. 25 And if a woman have an issue of her blood many days out of the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; all the days of the issue of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation : she shall be unclean. 26 Every bed whereon she lieth all the days of her issue shall be unto her as the bed of her separation: and whatsoever she sitteth upon shall be unclean, as the uncleanness of her separation. 27 And whosoever toucheth those things shall be unclean, and shall wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the even. 28 But if she be cleansed of her issue, then she shall number to herself seven days, and after that she shall be clean. 29 And on the eighth day she shall take unto her two turtles, or two young pigeons, and bring them unto the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. 30 And the priest shall offer the one for a burnt offering, and the other for a burnt offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for her before the LORD for the issue of her uncleanness. 31 Thus shall ye separate the children of Israel from their uncleanness; that they die not in their uncleanness, when they defile my tabernacle that is among them.

What does a "woman" with an <u>issue of blood</u> running many days/years past normal of 7 days represent <u>Spiritually</u>?

What does the "issue of blood" represent?

UNCLEANESS = SIN



WASH = Cleanse from sin

<u>Isaiah 1:16</u> "Wash you, make you clean put away the evil of your doing from before mine eyes; cease to do evil."

What are the results of having an "issue of blood" for a long time

- 1 **No** <u>relationship</u> with her **husband**.
- 2 No children.

What does a "Woman" with the "issue of blood" represent Spiritually?

A <u>Church</u> that is **sinning** and having <u>no relationship</u> with <u>Jesus</u> and producing <u>no converts</u>!

4 Was there anything significant about the woman "coming behind" Jesus instead of meeting Him face to face?


Matthew 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, <u>get thee</u> <u>behind me</u>, <u>satan</u>: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

Genesis 19:17 And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not **behind thee** neither stay thou in all the plain: escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed. **26** But his wife looked back from **behind him**, and she became a pillar of salt.

SIN is to be "BEHIND US"!

The woman was admitting her SINFULNESS
BY COMING "BEHIND JESUS"


5 What does the "garment" represent Spiritually?



GARMENT = Character or life

Genesis 35:2 "... Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments.

Zechariah 3:4 ". . . Take away the <u>filthy</u> garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused <u>thine iniquity</u> to pass from thee, and <u>I will clothe thee</u> with <u>change</u> of raiment."



NEW GARMENT = New righteous life (Clean, White)


Isaiah 61:10 "... My soul shall be joyful in my God for He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, He hath covered me with the robe of righteousness..."

Revelation 19:8 "And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints."

A persons "LIFE" or "CHARACTER"

In this case the "LORDS RIGHTEOUS LIFE"

6 Was there anything significant about the "hem" of the garment?



BORDER OR HEM = GOD'S LAW (10 Commandments)

Numbers 15:37-40 "And the Lord spake unto Moses saying speak unto the children of Israel... that they make... borders of their garments.. that they put upon the... borders a ribband of blue... that ye may look upon it and remember all the commandments of the Lord, and do them..."

THE "HEM" or "BORDER" REPRESENTS "GOD'S LAW

LUKE 8

43 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any, **44** came behind *him*, and touched the **border** of his garment : and immediately her issue of blood stanched.

7 Was it <u>necessary</u> to "touch" the "hem" of the garment or was it just an accident and insignificant Spiritually?
What does it mean to "touch"?

It was <u>necessary</u> to "touch" the **hem** of garment because it **symbolized** a <u>willingness</u> to keep **God's Law** (10 commandments).

MATTHEW 14

34 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gĕn-nĕs'-a-rĕt. **35** And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and **brought** unto him **all that were diseased**; **36** And besought him that **they** might only **touch** the **hem** of <u>his garment</u>: and <u>as many as **touched**</u> were <u>made perfectly whole</u>.

What does it mean to "touch"

TOUCH

If I may but *t* his garment..... Mt 9:21 # 680 to attach oneself to to touch

From # 681 to fasten to

To "touch" means to "<u>fasten oneself</u>" or <u>attach oneself</u> to. It implies a determination to "<u>not let go</u>" of the <u>10 commandment</u> Law, but rather to continue "holding on to it" or **keeping it**!

8 What did the woman <u>have to **do**</u> in order to "**touch**" the **hem** of Jesus garment?
What does this imply?

The woman had to **get down on her knees**.

This implies she was **humble** and had a **prayerful** attitude.

9 What did the woman have that allowed Jesus to heal her?

The woman had faith!

10 What does it mean to be made "whole"?

WHOLE

thy faith hath made thee **whole**.... Mt 9:22 #4982 safe to save, deliver, protect, make whole

To be "<u>made whole</u>" means to be made "**safe** to save". It also means to be "**delivered**" (from sin) and to be "**protected**" (from satan) as well as to be made <u>Physically</u> **well** or **healed**!!

BIBLE VERSE

MAT 9:20 And, behold, a **woman**, which was diseased with an **issue of blood** twelve years, **came behind him**, and touched the **hem** of his **garment**: 21 For she said within herself, If I may but **touch** his garment, I shall be **whole**. But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

PARAPHRASE

Behold a **Church** (woman) which for a long time (12 years) had people in it who were **willfully sinning** (issue of blood) against the Lord. During this time they did **not** have a **relationship** <u>with</u> <u>Jesus</u>, nor were they bringing **new converts** into the church.

Then, the **Church** (woman) realized her condition and went to Jesus with a <u>prayerful</u> and <u>humble attitude</u> and <u>admitted</u> her **sinfulness** (came behind him).

Individuals in the **Church** (woman) wanted to be <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> <u>like Jesus</u>, (reached for <u>His garment</u>), and to keep His **Commandments** (**Hem** of His garment). Because of the **faith** of these individuals in the **Church** (woman), God granted their wish and they were made "<u>Safe to Save</u>" (whole).
